#### NOTES TO THE ABBREVIATED FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 30 JUNE 2005

#### 1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The principal accounting policies adopted in the preparation of the financial statements are set out below and have remained unchanged from the previous year, and also have been consistently applied within the same financial statements.

#### **Turnover**

The company's turnover represents the value, excluding Value Added Tax, of goods and services supplied to customers during the year.

#### **Basis of Preparation of Financial Statements**

The full financial statements, from which these abbreviated financial statements have been extracted, have been prepared in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective June 2002) under the historical cost convention.

The effect of events in relation to the year ended 30 June 2005 which occurred before the date of approval of the financial statements by the director, have been included in the statements to the extent required to show a true and fair view of the state of affairs at 30 June 2005 and of the results for the year ended on that date.

#### Depreciation

Depreciation has been computed to write off the cost of tangible fixed assets over their expected useful lives using the following rate and method:

Equipment

- 20% per annum reducing balance

#### Stocks

Stocks have been valued at the lower of cost and net realisable value.

#### **Deferred Taxation**

Deferred tax arises as a result of including items of income and expenditure in taxation computations in periods different from those in which they are included in the company's financial statements. Deferred tax is provided in full on timing differences which result in an obligation to pay more tax at a future date, at the average tax rates that are expected to apply when timing differences reverse, based on current tax rates and laws.

#### **Pension Costs**

The company operates a pension scheme for the benefit of its director. The scheme is a defined contribution scheme and the contributions are charged against profits as they are paid.
