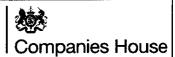

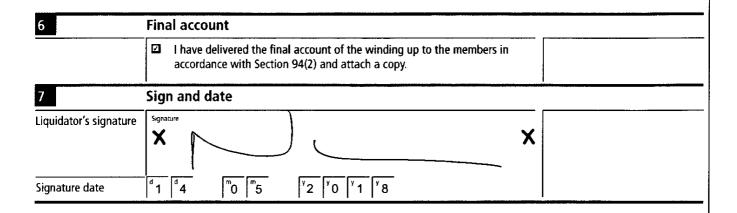

LIQUIDATION APPOINTMENT DETAILS

Nimish Patel was appointed Liquidator of the Company on the 31 January 2018.

2. INTRODUCTION

The purpose of this report is to provide a final report to members and to put members on notice of the Liquidator's intention to seek release from office. The report details the acts and dealing of the Liquidator and it should be read in conjunction with previous correspondence to members.

3. ADMINISTRATION AND PLANNING

The Liquidator is required to meet a considerable number of statutory and regulatory obligations. Whilst many of these tasks do not have a direct benefit, they assist in the efficient and compliant progressing of the Liquidation, which ensures that the Liquidator and his staff carry out our work to high professional standards. The narrative detail in respect of these tasks may be found in Appendix 4.

4. ASSET REALISATIONS

The Liquidator's Receipts & Payments Account for the period from 31 January 2018 to 6 April 2018 is enclosed at Appendix 1.

As set out in the Declaration of Solvency sworn by the Director prior to the commencement of the Liquidation, the only assets available in the Liquidation was Debtors amounting to £1,441,170.

The aforementioned assets were distributed in specie to the shareholders.



5. CREDITORS

According to the Declaration of Solvency, the Company had no liabilities. A notice to creditors to prove their claims in the Liquidation was advertised in the London Gazette. There were no forthcoming claims received as a result of this advertisement.

6. DISTRIBUTIONS TO SHAREHOLDERS

In accordance with the resolutions passed by the members in the special meeting of the Company held on 31 January 2018, the only asset of the Company was Debtors, which was distributed in specie to the Company's shareholders.

7. COSTS AND EXPENSES

Liquidator's Remuneration

The Liquidator's time costs for the period 31 January 2018 to 6 April 2018 totals £6,248.50 representing 32.50 hours at an average hourly rate of £192. The time costs are detailed at Appendix 2. The work undertaken in respect of these fees is detailed at Appendix 3 as well as within the body of the report.

RELEVANT EXTRACTS OF RULES 18.9 AND 18.34 OF THE INSOLVENCY (ENGLAND & WALES) RULES 2016

Rule 18.9

- (1) The following may make a written request to the office-holder for further information about remuneration or expenses set out in a final report under rule 18.14:
- members of the company in a members' voluntary winding up with at least 5% of the total voting rights of all the members having the right to vote at general meetings of the company; or
- any member of the company in a members' voluntary winding up with the permission of the court.
- (2) A request or an application to the court for permission by such a person or persons must be made or filed with the court (as applicable) within 21 days of receipt of the report by the person, or by the last of them in the case of an application by more than one member.

Rule 18.34

- (1) This rule applies to an application in a winding-up made by a person mentioned in paragraph (2) on the grounds that:
- the remuneration charged by the office-holder is in all the circumstances excessive;
- the basis fixed for the office-holder's remuneration under rules 18.16, 18.18, 18.19, 18.20 and 18.21 (as applicable) is inappropriate; or
- the expenses incurred by the office-holder are in all the circumstances excessive.
- (2) The following may make such an application for one or more of the orders set out in rule 18.36 or 18.37 as applicable in a members' voluntary winding up:
- members of the company with at least 10% of the total voting rights of all the members having the right to vote at general meetings of the company, or
- a member of the company with the permission of the court.
- (3) The application by a member must be made no later than eight weeks after receipt by the applicant of the final report or account under rule 18.14 which first reports the charging of the remuneration or the incurring of the expenses in question.
