1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

1.1 Accounting Convention

The financial statements are prepared under the historical cost convention and include the results of the company's operations as indicated in the directors report, all of which are continuing.

The company has taken advantage of the exemption in Financial Reporting Standard No. 1 from the requirement to produce a cashflow statement on the grounds that it is a small company.

1.2 Turnover

Turnover represents amounts receivable for goods sold and services provided excluding VAT.
