The trustees present herewith their annual report, together with the financial statement of the society for the twelve month period ended 31 December 2013

Corporate status

The Society was incorporated on 29 December 1995 as a company limited by guarantee. It has no issued share capital and the liability of its members is limited to a sum not exceeding £1.

Results

The net outgoing expenditure of the Society for the period amounted to £ 270.36
The total funds for the Society amounted to £3030.93 on 31 December 2013. All members of the Society have received a copy of the annual report and financial statements, copies of which are available from the Society Secretary.

Principal activity

The Society is a registered charity established to provide or assist in the transfer of appropriate technologies to schools, institutions of higher learning and other centres in Eritrea which combat poverty, sickness and underdevelopment. Following the successful completion of a project to send computers to the Keren Public Library and the Adi Ugri Secondary School in Eritrea, members of the Society and their supporters in Manchester and Merseyside have been collecting books and materials to support other schools and orphanages.


Board of trustees
