NOTES TO THE ABBREVIATED ACCOUNTS

YEAR ENDED 31 MARCH 2009

1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Basis of accounting

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective January 2007).

Turnover

The turnover recognised in the profit and loss account represents the amounts derived from the rental of the dry docks and associated buildings on a straight line basis over the term of the lease.

Depreciation

Depreciation is calculated so as to write off the cost of an asset, less its estimated residual value, over the useful economic life of that asset as follows:

Plant & Machinery

10% straight line

Deferred taxation

Deferred tax is recognised in respect of all timing differences that have originated but not reversed at the balance sheet date where transactions or events have occurred at that date that will result in an obligation to pay more, or a right to pay less or to receive more tax, with the following exceptions:

Provision is made for tax on gains arising from the revaluation (and similar fair value adjustments) of fixed assets, and gains on disposal of fixed assets that have been rolled over into replacement assets, only to the extent that, at the balance sheet date, there is a binding agreement to dispose of the assets concerned. However, no provision is made where, on the basis of all available evidence at the balance sheet date, it is more likely than not that the taxable gain will be rolled over into replacement assets and charged to tax only where the replacement assets are sold.

Deferred tax assets are recognised only to the extent that the directors consider that it is more likely than not that there will be suitable taxable profits from which the future reversal of the underlying timing differences can be deducted.

Deferred tax is measured on an undiscounted basis at the tax rates that are expected to apply in the periods in which timing differences reverse, based on tax rates and laws enacted or substantively enacted at the balance sheet date.

Investment properties

The value at which investment properties are included in the financial statements reflects the open market valuation at the balance sheet date.

No depreciation is provided against investment properties in accordance with SSAP 19. This represents a departure from Companies Act 1985, which the directors consider to be necessary in order for the financial statements to give a true and fair view.

If this departure had not been made, the profit for the financial year would have been reduced by depreciation. However the amount of depreciation cannot reasonably be quantified because depreciation is only one of many factors reflected in the valuation and the amount which might otherwise have been shown cannot be separately identified or quantified.

Included within fixed assets are assets which are leased to customers under operating leases. The gross amounts of assets leased are £112,405 (2008 £112,405) with a total depreciation charge of £109,853 (2008 £98,611).

The investment property is included in the accounts at open market value at 31 March 2009, as valued by the directors of the company.

3. RELATED PARTY TRANSACTIONS

During the year, the company paid management charges to Carnegie International Asset Management Limited and Havana West Limited of £nil (2008 - £100,000), and £42,500 (2008 - £70,088) respectively. Both companies are related by virtue of L L de Savary being a common director.

During the year, the company also invoiced £nil (2008 - £60,000) to Havana West Limited for management charges. This was on an arms-length basis.

Included in 'Other Creditors' is £104,161 (2008 - £41,253) in respect of amounts owed to Havana West Limited and £nil (2008 - £98,392) in respect of amounts owed to Carnegie International Asset Management Limited.

The company is controlled on a day to day basis by L L de Savary, a director and shareholder of the company.
