

1 Ownership

British Gas Energy Limited is a direct wholly owned subsidiary undertaking of GB Gas Holdings Limited. At the balance sheet date, GB Gas Holdings Limited was a wholly owned subsidiary undertaking of Centrica plc, the ultimate parent company at that date.
