Part 1 – Form of the assistance:

The assistance will take the form of the execution and delivery by the Company of the following documents, and the Company fulfilling its obligations under them:

- 1. an unlimited inter company composite guarantee (the "Guarantee") to be entered into by the Company in favour of National Westminster Bank Plc (the "Bank") pursuant to which the Company will (amongst other things) guarantee the repayment of and indemnify the Bank for all moneys from time to time owed to the Bank by The Mission Marketing Group plc (Company No. 05733632) (the "Buyer") and its subsidiaries listed therein;
- 2. a debenture (the "**Debenture**") to be entered into by the Company in favour of the Bank granting first fixed charges over the assets identified in the debenture and a first floating charge over the remainder of the Company's undertaking;
- 3. an intragroup loan agreement (the "Intragroup Loan Agreement") to be entered into by, *inter alia*, the Company and the Buyer which sets out the terms of a revolving credit facility to be made available by the Company to the Buyer.

Part 2 – Principal terms of the assistance:

The principal terms on which the assistance will be given are as follows:

- 1. under the Guarantee the Company (amongst other things) covenants to pay, and guarantees the payment of, all moneys from time to time owed to the Bank by the Buyer and its subsidiaries listed therein;
- 2. under the Debenture, the Company covenants to pay on demand all obligations of the Company to the Bank from time to time, including those under the Guarantee. Further, it grants first fixed charges over the assets identified in the Debenture and a first floating charge over the remainder of the Company's undertaking, by way of security for all obligations of the Company to the Bank from time to time, including those under the Guarantee. The Company covenants further (amongst other things) that it will at its own cost, at the Bank's request, execute any deed or document and take any action required by the Bank to perfect the Bank's security or further to secure on the Property (as defined therein) the Company's Obligations (as defined therein);



3. under the Intragroup Loan Agreement, the Company agrees to make available to the Buyer a revolving credit facility bearing interest and to be repaid on the Termination Date (as defined therein).

Part 3

The amount of cash to be transferred to the person assisted is any amount loaned by the Company to the Borrower pursuant to the Intragroup Loan Agreement.

Part 4

The date on which the assistance is to be given is within 8 weeks of the date of this declaration.
