1 Accounting policies

1.1 Accounting convention

1.2 Turnover

Tumover represents amounts receivable for music performances, from government grants and private sponsorship.

1.3 Grants received

Grants are credited to deferred revenue. Grants towards capital expenditure are released to the profit and loss account over the expected useful life of the assets. Grants towards revenue expenditure are released to the profit and loss account as the related expenditure is incurred.
