1. Accounting policies

These financial statements are prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with applicable United Kingdom law and accounting standards. The following accounting policies have been applied consistently in dealing with items which are considered material in relation to the financial statements.

Going concern

The financial statements have been prepared on a going concern basis, notwithstanding net current liabilities of £1,431,000 which the Directors believe to be appropriate for the following reasons,

The Company's balance sheet contains only investments in subsidiary undertakings and amounts due to subsidiary undertakings. The Company is dormant and the Directors neither expect it to trade nor for there to be any cash flows in the foreseeable future.

Cash flow exemption

The Company has taken advantage of the exemption, conferred by Finanical Reporting Standard 1 (Revised), from presenting a cash flow statement as it is a wholly owned subsidiary of a group, which prepares a consolidated cash flow statement

Consolidation

The Company has claimed exemption from the preparation of consolidated financial statements under section 400 of the Companies Act 2006 as it is a subsidiary of a group which has prepared consolidated financial statements. Accordingley, these financial statements present information about the Company and not the group

Investments

Investments are held at cost less provision for any impairment

2. Profit and loss account

No profit and loss account is presented with these financial statements because the Company has not received income, incurred expenditure or recognised any gains or losses during either the year ended 31 December 2010 or the previous financial year

7. Contingent liabilities

- a) The Company is a member of a group VAT registration and as such has contingent liabilities for VAT in respect of other members of the Group
- b) On 21 December 2006, the Company was a party to the refinancing of Azincourt Investment, SL ("Azincourt") and its subsidiary companies. Azincourt was the company used by Fomento de Construcciones y Contratas, S A ("FCC") for the acquisition of WRG and its subsidiary undertakings, including the Company. The Company agreed to advance funds to Azincourt under the Group's cash pooling arrangements for the purposes of, among other things, the repayment of principal, interest or other amounts under the Facility Agreement, or the payment of any other costs or expenses incurred by Azincourt directly or indirectly in connection with its acquisition of WRG. The Company also entered in to a floating charge over all its present and future rights, title and interest to the cash pooling account and all amounts credited to it in its favour.
- c) The Group must comply with the Environment Agency's financial provisioning requirements for its landfill sites in England and Wales, which is satisfied by providing financial security bonds totalling £92 1 million. The Company is an indemnifying party to the bonds and therefore has contingent liabilities for environmental provisions in respect of other members of the Group.

9. Ultimate parent company

The immediate parent of the Company is Waste Recycling Group Limited, a company registered in England and Wales The Directors regard Fomento de Construcciones y Contratas, S.A., a company registered in Spain, as the ultimate parent entity and Esther Koplowitz Romero de Juseu to be the ultimate controlling party
