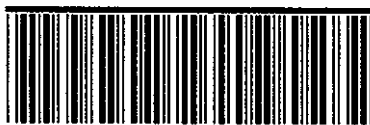

What is the Bryncynon Community Revival Strategy?

The strategy emerged from the local Residents Association who felt the need to combat the problems and difficulties faced by the loss of the coal mining industry and associated jobs. The aim is to look at ways in which the local community can improve their quality of life and future prospects.

The group were successful in gaining support from a wide range of organisations and in the Spring of 1994 we gained Community Revival Strategy monies from the Welsh Office Strategic Development Scheme and Cynon Valley Borough Council now Rhondda Cynon Taff County Borough Council. This was matched in August of 1995 with support from the European Regional Development Fund.

The strategy is managed by a Company Ltd by Guarantee and the Board of Directors are made up of representatives from local community groups, businesses, councillors and schools. The Board are currently seeking Charitable Status.



What are we aiming to achieve?

The strategy is made up of five elements; education and training, social and recreational, health gain, economic development and environmental improvements.

The Bryncynon Community Development Centre (opposite the Londis, Commercial Place, Tynte) comprises of computer and language equipment as well as a meeting place or seminar facility. The community centre has been re-furbished and alongside this an all weather playing surface has been built. The nursery and health clinic has just been completed, the day nursery will have placements for up to fifteen children from the ages of six weeks to five years.

The success of the strategy is very dependent upon your support and also on our partners.

The opportunities for the local community are immense!

What are the opportunities?

The chance to train in information technology and learn languages, beginners courses in computers and Welsh have already begun with many more to follow in 1997!

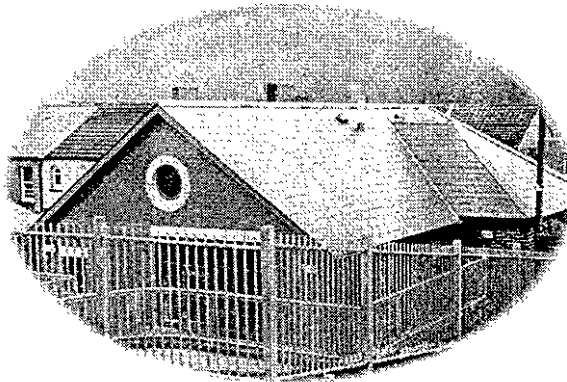
There are many opportunities for young people with the development of special projects, combining the use of our equipment with their interests, eg. animation and music projects.

We have an outdoor activities club which is already proving a success with young people and we intend extending these opportunities to adults.

We have an after school club for children between the ages of 10 and 15 and we plan to develop a playscheme for 1997. A group of local women are already training as playworkers with the view to organising activities over the holiday periods.

The opening of the Health Clinic will provide an opportunity to develop further initiatives which will benefit the health of the community.

The day nursery will provide much needed placements for children of working parents and for those training on courses. The nursery will also provide a valuable role in terms of childcare training.



This is just the beginning!

Information Technology in the Community

Courses for the Community



Introductory Courses - for beginners

These courses will give you an opportunity to learn about various aspects of IT for the first time. They involve four week introductory workshops and contain no assessment. The course will cover the basic features of wordprocessing.

Day and evening course available. Tuesdays 1.00-3.00 and Thursdays 6.30-8.30

No background knowledge or experience needed.

Drop in Computer Workshop - for those with some knowledge of computers

Work at your own pace with the support of a tutor. This workshop will give you an opportunity to build on your wordprocessing skills, combined with spreadsheets and presentation graphics. It is for those who have completed a beginners course and who feel confident to work on their own for part of the time.

Information Technology in the Community

Every day IT - for those who have completed a beginners course or who have some knowledge of computers

This course will provide an understanding of the use of IT in organisations and the use of IT in developing resource materials such as spreadsheets, wordprocessing, presentation graphics. This is a course for those beginners with some IT knowledge. Assessment will be entirely through coursework.

This course will give you twelve credits towards a Higher Education Certificate. (a full year is 120 credits) This award can be built on to diploma and degree level at any Higher Education Institute in Wales.

Cost £37.50 for 15 weeks, £2.50 for unwaged.

Thursday 10.00-12.00, you will need to spend additional time in the computer drop in workshop which follows in the afternoon session.

RSA Clait Computer Literacy and Information Technology

Stage 1 & 2

This course is initially over a period of ten weeks and will cover spreadsheets, database and wordprocessing and the use of graphics.

There will be progression from stage 1 to 2 if you so wish.

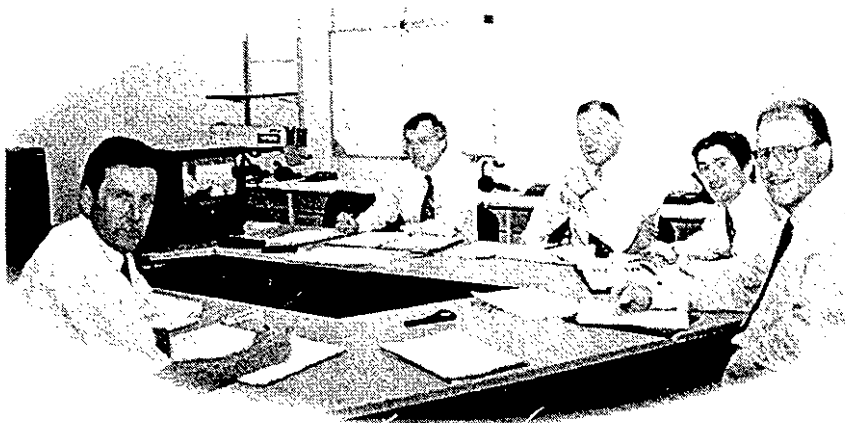
Day Nursery

We also organise courses in IT and languages for businesses.



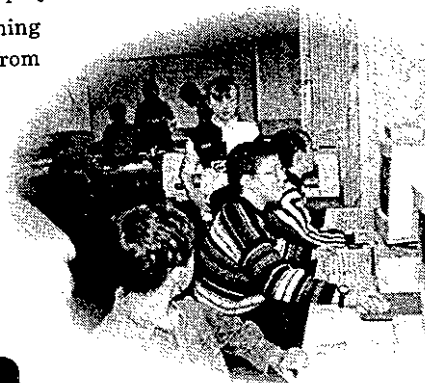

Over the last two years many young people from the community have been involved in various outdoor activities organised in partnership with Merthyr and Groundwork Trust. These activities range from rock climbing, canoeing, mountain biking, hill walking and camping. Recently we have started the Duke of Edinburgh Award Scheme, presently we have nine young people aged between 14 and 17 learning to map read ready for their first expedition in the summer of 1997. We hope that this will grow as this award is both challenging and rewarding for young people. If you are interested you need to be between the ages of 13 and 23.



We believe that the outdoors should be enjoyed by young and old alike and we aim to set up an outdoor activity club in the area which will provide opportunities for all ages. This does not necessarily mean that you have to do rock climbing or canoeing!
