#### 1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

#### 1 1 Basis of preparation of financial statements

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with applicable accounting standards

#### 1.2 Cash flow statement

The company is a wholly owned subsidiary of Rolls-Royce plc and is included in the consolidated financial statements of Rolls-Royce plc, which are publicly available. Consequently, the company has taken advantage of the exemption from preparing a cash flow statement under the terms of FRS1.

#### 1.3 Related party transactions

The company has taken advantage of the exemption in FRS8 not to disclose related party transactions with other group companies

#### 1.4 Going concern

The financial statements have been prepared on the going concern basis, notwithstanding net liabilities of £6,333,773, (2009 £6,333,773) which the directors believe to be appropriate for the following reasons. The company is dependent for its working capital on funds provided to it by Rolls-Royce Power Development Limited, the company's immediate parent. Rolls-Royce Power Development Limited has indicated that for at least 12 months from the date of approval of these financial statements, it will continue to make available such funds as are needed by the company and in particular will not seek repayment of the amounts currently made available. The directors consider that this should enable the company to continue in operational existence for the foreseeable future by meeting its liabilities as they fall due for payment. As with any company placing reliance on other group entities for financial support, the directors acknowledge that there can be no certainty that this support will continue although, at the date of approval of these financial statements, they have no reason to believe that it will not do so
