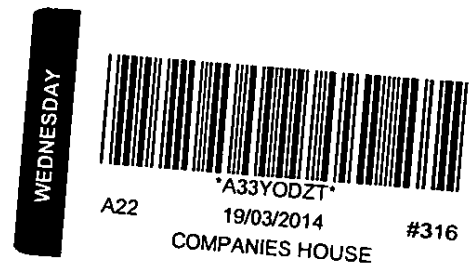

1 Accounting policies
