**AND UPON READING THE EVIDENCE**

**AND IT APPEARING THAT** the name of Mayflower Automotive Products (UK) Ltd was struck off the Register of Companies in pursuance of the provisions of Section 652 of the Companies Act 1985

**AND** the Court being satisfied on the evidence that the EC Regulation does apply and that these proceedings are main proceedings as defined in Article 3 of the EC Regulation

**AND** there being no opposition on behalf of Her Majesty to the relief sought by the said Petition

**IT IS ORDERED THAT :**

1. the name of Mayflower Automotive Products (UK) Ltd be restored to the Register of Companies
2. Mayflower Automotive Products (UK) Ltd be wound up by this Court under the provisions of the Insolvency Act 1986
3. the costs of the Petitioner of the Petition be paid out of the assets of the Company
