The Company had no known creditors A notice to creditors to prove their claims in the liquidation was advertised in The London Gazette on 25 November 2014 No creditors were forthcoming as a result of this advertisement

Tax

The Company's tax advisors advised that the Company had dormant corporation tax status Following their appointment, the joint liquidators sought and received confirmation from HM Revenue and Customs ("HMRC") that the Company had no outstanding corporation tax returns or liabilities, that it would not raise enquiries into any pre or post liquidation periods and that it had no objection to the liquidators calling a final meeting of members to conclude the liquidation

A similar assurance was sought and received from HMRC in respect of PAYE

The Company was not registered for VAT

Distributions

On 23 September 2015 the Joint Liquidators declared a first and final distribution of the assets of the Company to Grainger plc as the sole beneficial shareholder of the Company

The distribution was at the rate of £1 per £1 ordinary share and was effected by set off against the debt of £1 due to the Company by Grainger plc

Joint Liquidators' remuneration and expenses

A written resolution was passed on 14 November 2014 that the remuneration of the Joint Liquidators be fixed at their normal charging rates according to the time properly spent by them and members of their staff in attending to matters arising in the winding up of the Company
