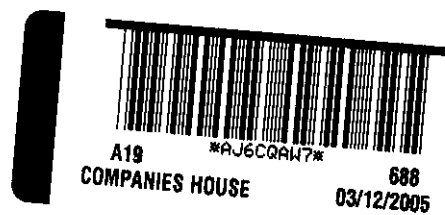

For the year ended 31 December 2004 the Company was entitled to and claimed the small-companies exemption under section 249AA(1) of the Companies Act 1985.


No members have required the Company to obtain an audit of its accounts for the year in question in accordance with section 249B(2).

### 1 Ownership

Dyno-Services Limited is a direct wholly-owned subsidiary undertaking of Dyno-Rod Limited. At the balance sheet date, Dyno-Rod Limited was an indirect subsidiary undertaking of Centrica plc, the ultimate parent company at that date.
