The declaration of solvency, sworn by the directors prior to the commencement of the liquidation, showed neither assets nor liabilities.

The Company had no known creditors. A notice to creditors to prove their claims in the liquidation was advertised in the London Gazette on 16 February 2018. No creditors were forthcoming as a result of this advertisement.

Our search of the Land Registry showed two land titles registered in the Company's name. Following investigation, it was established that the two land titles were in fact erroneous/legacy entries that are either no longer applicable or hold no value. It was agreed with the Company's parent that rather than incurring further expenses in dealing with these, the Joint Liquidators' should proceed to conclude the liquidation without taking any further action on these titles.

Tax

The Company's tax advisors advised that the Company had dormant corporation tax status. Following their appointment, the Joint Liquidators sought and received confirmation from HM Revenue and Customs ("HMRC") that the Company had no outstanding corporation tax returns or liabilities, that it would not raise enquiries into any pre or post liquidation periods and that it had no objection to the Liquidators proceeding to finalise the liquidation.

A similar assurance was sought and received from HMRC in respect of PAYE and VAT matters.

Distributions

There were no assets available for distribution to shareholders.

Joint Liquidators' remuneration and expenses

A written resolution was passed on 6 February 2018 that the remuneration of the Joint Liquidators be fixed at their normal charging rates according to the time properly spent by them and members of their staff in attending to matters arising in the winding up of the Company.

In the event, the Joint Liquidators' remuneration and expenses has been paid by a third party and accordingly, no detailed analysis is included in this report.

The Joint Liquidators will now proceed to finalise the liquidation.
