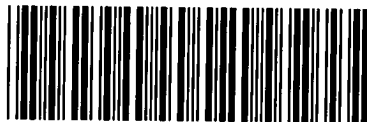

### 1. Accounting policies

#### Company information

Renaissance Securities Limited ("the Company") is a limited company domiciled and incorporated in England. The address of the Company's registered office and principal place of business is Berkeley House, 304 Regents Park Road, London, N3 2JX. The principal activity of the company during the year was that of a dormant company.

#### 1.1 Basis of accounting

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with applicable accounting standards.
