The Directors present their strategic report on Billetts International Limited ("the Company") for the year ended 31 December 2018.

REVIEW OF THE BUSINESS

The Company did not trade during the current or prior financial year.

The Company is a wholly owned subsidiary of BCMG Limited, a company incorporated in England and Wales, which itself is ultimately owned by Ebiquity plc, a company incorporated in England and Wales.

The Company has not traded during the current or preceding financial year and accordingly no profit and loss account has been prepared.

The Statement of Financial Position remained at total net assets of £25,000 (31 December 2017: £25,000) since the Company has not traded in the financial year.

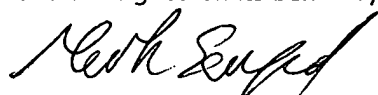
DIRECTORS' INDEMNITY

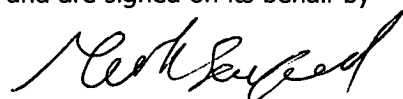
For the year ended 31 December 2018 the company was entitled to exemption from audit under section 480 of the Companies Act 2006 relating to dormant companies.
