- 1.1 I, Michael David Rollings together with my colleague Steven Edward Butt, of Rollings Butt LLP, 6 Snow Hill, London, EC1A 2AY, was appointed as Joint Liquidator of QSoft Consulting Limited ("the Company") on 24 June 2015. The affairs of the Company are now fully wound-up and this is my final account of the liquidation, which covers the period since my last progress report ("the Period").
- 1.2 The trading address of the Company was 1 The Green, Richmond, Surrey, TW9 1PL.
- 1.3 The registered office of the Company was changed to 6 Snow Hill, London, EC1A 2AY and its registered number is 03472519.

#### 2 Receipts and Payments

2.1 At Appendix A, I have provided an account of my Receipts and Payments for the Period with a comparison to the directors' Declaration of Solvency, together with a cumulative account since my appointment at Appendix B, which provides details of the remuneration charged and expenses incurred and paid by the Liquidators

#### 3 Work undertaken by the Liquidators

- 3.1 This section of the report provides creditors with an overview of the work undertaken in the liquidation since 24 June 2017, together with information on the overall outcome of the liquidation.
- 3.2 Prior to the most recent progress report became due, clearance in respect of all taxes had been received and the liquidation was in a position to be concluded. However, as described in the previous report, the Company received an unexpected refund in respect of PAYE which included a small amount of interest. As the interest was a chargeable gain, the liquidators were therefore required to submit a further Corporation Tax return and receive further clearance before distributing the final funds held in the liquidation.
- 3.3 During the Period, further Corporation Tax clearance was sought and received. We have therefore also distributed the remaining funds held in the liquidation account to the sole shareholder.

#### Unrealisable Assets

3.4 There are no unrealisable assets.

#### 4 Distributions to Members

- 4.1 The following cash distributions to members have been made:
  - An interim distribution of £2,300,000 being a return representing 2300 pence per 1 pence ordinary share on 5 May 2016.
  - A final distribution of 85.79 pence per 1 pence ordinary share on 14 September 2017.

#### 5 Liquidators' Remuneration

5.1 The members approved that the basis of the Liquidators' remuneration be fixed by reference to the time properly spent by them and their staff in managing the liquidation

- 5.2 My time costs for the period from 24 June 2017 are £2,072. This represents 11.60 hours at an average rate of £178.62 per hour. Attached as Appendix C is a Time Analysis which provides details of the activity costs incurred by staff grade during this period in respect of the costs fixed by reference to time properly spent by me in managing the Liquidation. I would confirm that £20,000 plus disbursements of £1,617.10 has been drawn and that no further fees will be taken.
- 5.3 Also, attached as Appendix D is a cumulative Time Analysis for the period from 24 June 2015 to 19 September 2017 which provides details of my total time costs since the date of my appointment.
- 5.4 I can advise that since my last progress report on the liquidation dated 24 June 2017 I have drawn no further fees or disbursements.
- 5.5 Attached as Appendix E is additional information in relation to this firm's policy on staffing, the use of subcontractors, disbursements and details of our current charge-out rates by staff grade.
