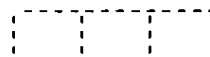

In accordance with section 104A of the Insolvency Act 1986 and further to my appointment as liquidator of the above-named company on 30 April 2012, I, Tim Alexander Clunie, give progress report for the year ended 29 April 2013 to the Members and Creditors of the company, as follows

I am not in a position to conclude the liquidation as its administration is continuing

Receipts and Payments Account

1 Receipts and Payments Account

There have been no receipts in this liquidation. All costs of possession and maintenance of this administration have been met by liquidator personally. The receipts and payments are as described in the attached Receipts and Payments account.

2 Preferential Creditors and Other creditors

There are no preferential creditors in this liquidation.
I regret, as stated previously, that unsecured creditors are not likely to receive a distribution in this liquidation.

3 Liquidation fees and disbursements

The basis of remuneration was fixed by the members and creditors of the company, respectively, at their first meetings at the time of my appointment. My office has spent 22.50 hours up to date giving a charge of £5,400.00 at an average rate of £240.00 per hour. The payment for expenses and disbursements met by liquidator are purely 'category 1' disbursements. A recovery of fees and disbursements has not been possible in this case due to lack of realizations, however, should a recovery be made to the date of closure, it will be used firstly to discharge of fees and costs of liquidator.

4 Other matters

- As liquidator, I have conformed to the requirements set out under the reporting provisions of the Insolvency Act 1986.
- There are no assets of which I am aware that remain to be realized, however, the liquidation is kept open should a recovery be possible from a connected company, where enquiries are continuing.
- The creditors and members have right to request further information, by writing to the liquidator and duty of liquidator to provide information under rule 4.49E of the Insolvency Rules 1986 about remuneration or expenses, set out in the progress report. All such written requests to the liquidator would be considered under the rule and provided the request is considered to be reasonable and not prejudicial to the conduct of the liquidation its compliance should follow within 14 days of receipt. The creditors and members may apply to Court for an order if either the liquidator does not comply with written request or it is sought to challenge remuneration or expenses as excessive under rule 4.131 of the Insolvency Rules 1986.
