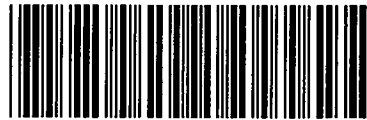

Directors' report for the year ended 31 July 2014

The directors submit their report and the financial statements for the year ended 31 July 2014.

Principal activities

The company is dormant, there have been no board meetings and no annual general meetings during the year.

The Company is a wholly owned subsidiary of Imperial Innovations Limited. The Company previously provided mentoring services, including finance expertise and material resources, to new companies based around technologies arising from research at Imperial College of Science, Technology and Medicine. As of 31 July 2001, all assets and liabilities of Imperial College Company Maker Limited were transferred to Imperial College. Subsequently these were transferred to Imperial Innovations Limited on 27 April 2005.

Future developments

The company is dormant and will continue to be so.

Directors' responsibilities

Under that law the directors have elected to prepare the financial statements in accordance with United Kingdom Generally Accepted Accounting Practice (United Kingdom Accounting Standards and applicable law). Under company law the directors must not approve the financial statements unless they are satisfied that they give a true and fair view of the state of affairs of the company and of the profit or loss of the company for that period. In preparing these financial statements, the directors are required to:

- select suitable accounting policies and then apply them consistently;
- make judgements and accounting estimates that are reasonable and prudent;
- state whether applicable UK accounting standards have been followed, subject to any material departures disclosed and explained in the financial statements;
- prepare the financial statements on a going concern basis unless it is inappropriate to presume the company will continue in business.

The directors are responsible for keeping adequate accounting records that are sufficient to show and explain the company's transactions and disclose with reasonable accuracy at any time the financial position of the company and enable them to ensure that the financial statements comply with the Companies Act 2006. They are also responsible for safeguarding the assets of the company and hence for taking reasonable steps for the prevention and detection of fraud and other irregularities.
