The declaration of solvency, sworn by the directors prior to the commencement of the liquidation, showed a debt totalling £81,550,000 due from BMW (UK) Holdings Limited, the Company's immediate parent.

The Company had no known creditors.

A notice to creditors to prove their claims in the liquidation was advertised in the London Gazette on 15 June 2018. No creditors were forthcoming as a result of this advertisement.

Tax

All pre-liquidation corporation tax matters were handled by BMW Group who prepared and submitted all outstanding returns up to the date of the commencement of the liquidation to HM Revenue & Customs ("HMRC"). At the request of the Joint Liquidators HMRC subsequently confirmed that the Company had no outstanding corporation tax returns or liabilities, that it would not raise enquiries into any pre or post liquidation periods and that it had no objection to the Liquidators taking steps to bring the liquidation to a conclusion.

A similar assurance was sought and received from HMRC in respect of PAYE and VAT matters.

The only outstanding matter is confirmation from the Stamp Duty office at HMRC that a revised stock transfer form has been accepted after the original form submitted contained errors. Once this confirmation has been received we can proceed to close the liquidation.

Distributions

There were no distributions made in the period.

Joint Liquidators' remuneration and expenses

A written resolution was passed on 06 June 2018 that the remuneration of the Joint Liquidators be fixed at their normal charging rates according to the time properly spent by them and members of their staff in attending to matters arising in the winding up of the Company.

In the event, the Liquidators' remuneration and expenses totalling £8,480 have been paid by BMW (UK) Holdings Limited and accordingly no detailed analysis is included in this report.

Closure

Once the share rectification issue referred to above has been resolved the Joint Liquidators will proceed to finalise the liquidation.
