It is the policy of the charity to reduce reserves, over the next 3 to 5 years, by distributing funds to assist in the provision of care in line with the objects of the charity. Future administration costs are anticipated to be minimal and therefore significant funds will not be required to be maintained to cover this expenditure. However, the trustees believe that reserves should be maintained at a minimum of £5,000 to enable them to meet any future care costs.

Risk factors

The trustees have assessed the major risks to which the charity is exposed, and are satisfied that systems are in place to mitigate exposure to the major risks.

NOTES TO THE ACCOUNTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 MARCH 2005

1 Accounting policies

1.1 Basis of preparation

The accounts are prepared under the historical cost convention.

The charity has taken advantage of the exemption in Financial Reporting Standard No 1 from the requirement to produce a cash flow statement on the grounds that it is a small charity.

The accounts have been prepared in accordance with the Statement of Recommended Practice, "Accounting and Reporting by Charities" issued in October 2000 and applicable accounting standards.

1.2 Incoming resources

Fees for domiciliary services provided are included in incoming resources in the period in which the service is provided.

All other income is included when the charity is legally entitled to the income and the amount can be quantified with reasonable accuracy.

1.3 Resources expended

All expenditure is accounted for on an accruals basis inclusive of VAT.

Management and administration costs include all expenditure not directly related to the charitable activity. This includes the cost of renting and running office premises, administrative staff salaries and audit fees.

1.4 Tangible fixed assets and depreciation

Tangible fixed assets are stated at cost less depreciation. Depreciation is provided at rates calculated to write off the cost less estimated residual value of each asset over its expected useful life, as follows:
