Opinion



On 22/6/2015 we reported as auditors to the shareholders of the company on the full financial statements for the year ended 31 March 2015 prepared under Section 396 of the Companies Act 2006, and our report included the following extract:

"Emphasis of matter - Going concern

In forming our opinion on the financial statements, which is not qualified, we have considered the adequacy of the disclosures made in note 1 to the financial statements concerning the company's ability to continue as a going concern. The company made a loss for the financial year ended 31 March 2015 of £18,644 and at 31 March 2015 the company's total liabilities exceeded its total assets by £655,010. This along with the matters set out in note 1 to the financial statements indicates the existence of a material uncertainty which may cast significant doubt about the company's ability to continue as a going concern. The financial statements do not include the adjustments that would result if the company was unable to continue as a going concern."

NOTES TO THE ABBREVIATED ACCOUNTS
FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 MARCH 2015

1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Basis of preparing the financial statements

At 31 March 2015 the company has net liabilities of £655,010. The company has received confirmation from a group creditor which is owed £760,596 that it will not seek to demand repayment until the company is in a position to do so. The directors believe, therefore, that it is appropriate to prepare the accounts on a going concern basis.

Accounting convention

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective April 2008).

Turnover

Turnover represents royalty fees receivable net of VAT.

Deferred tax

Deferred tax is recognised in respect of all timing differences that have originated but not reversed at the balance sheet date.

Foreign currencies

Assets and liabilities in foreign currencies are translated into sterling at the rates of exchange ruling at the balance sheet date. Transactions in foreign currencies are translated into sterling at the rate of exchange ruling at the date of transaction. Exchange differences are taken into account in arriving at the operating result.
