Notes to the Abbreviated Accounts

Year Ended 31st March 2014

1. Accounting Policies

Accounting Convention

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention, and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective April 2008).

Turnover

Turnover represents the fair value of goods and services provided, excluding value added tax, during the year.

Fixed Assets

All fixed assets are initially recorded at cost.

Depreciation

Depreciation is calculated so as to write off the cost of an asset, less its estimated residual value, over the useful economic life of that asset as follows:

Plant & Machinery

- 25% Straight line per annum

Fixtures, Fittings & Equipment

- 25% Straight line per annum

Leasehold Property

- Straight line over the life of the lease

Stocks

Stocks are valued at the lower of cost and net realisable value, after making due allowance for obsolete and slow moving items.

Operating Lease Agreements

Rentals applicable to operating leases where substantially all of the benefits and risks of ownership remain with the lessor are charged against profits on a straight line basis over the period of the lease.

Deferred Taxation

Deferred tax is recognised in respect of all timing differences that have originated but not reversed at the balance sheet date where transactions or events have occurred at that date that will result in an obligation to pay more, or a right to pay less or to receive more tax.

Deferred tax is measured on an undiscounted basis at the tax rates that are expected to apply in the periods in which timing differences reverse, based on tax rates and laws enacted or substantively enacted at the balance sheet date.

Foreign Currencies

Assets and liabilities in foreign currencies are translated into sterling at the rates of exchange ruling at the balance sheet date. Transactions in foreign currencies are translated into sterling at the rate of exchange ruling at the date of the transaction. Exchange differences are taken into account in arriving at the operating profit.

3. Related Party Transactions

The company was under the control of A. Poilâne throughout the current and previous year.

During the year the company's ultimate parent company Poilâne SA, provided the company with a loan, balance outstanding at the end of the year £259,383 (2012 - £380,879). The loan has been provided interest free and with a formal repayment agreement.

During the year the company's ultimate parent company Poilâne SA provided an inter-company current account, balance outstanding at the end of the year £1,462,301 (2012 - £1,318,475). A commercial rate of interest is being applied, interest paid during the year £9,335 (2012 - 5,689).

During the year the company purchased goods and services, on an arms' length basis, to the value of £191,517 (2012 - £151,562) from Poilâne SA, the company's ultimate parent company.
