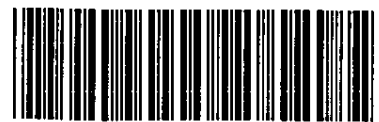

1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

- (a) The accounts have been prepared under the historical cost convention.
- (b) Turnover represents net commissions received and net invoiced sales of goods excluding VAT.
- (c) Tangible fixed assets
Depreciation is provided at the following annual rates in order to write off each asset over its estimated useful life
 - Fixtures and equipment 25% on net book value
 - Motor vehicles 25% on net book value
- (d) Stock
Stock is valued at the lower of cost and net realisable value after making due allowance for obsolete and slow moving items.
