 - (1) that the respective Applicant has been removed from office and replaced by the relevant replacement office holder ('the Replacement Office Holder');
 - (2) that the creditors have liberty to issue an application on notice within 28 days after the date of the report or advertising in the London Gazette, whichever is the earlier to vary or discharge the Order;
 - (3) that
 - (a) the respective Applicant will be entitled to apply to the Secretary of State for his release from liability after the expiry of a period of 28 days commencing with the date of the report in relation to liquidations and bankruptcies,
 - (b) the respective Applicant be released from liability in relation to those other matters listed in Schedules A-H not covered by sub paragraph (a) above 28 days after the date of the report;
- In the event that the next report due in each matter listed in the Schedules is due within 28 days of the making of this Order, an extension of a further 56 days after the due date shall be permitted for the drafting and circulation to creditors of such report;
- 7. A creditor of any of the estates listed in the Schedules shall have liberty to issue an application on notice within 28 days of the date of the report containing the notice referred to above or advertising in the London Gazette, whichever is the earlier, to vary or discharge the Order
- 8. The Proposals (and resolutions contained therein) to creditors in each administration be read as if the relevant replacement office holder was originally stated in place of the relevant original office holder, with the effect that where the original office holder was proposed and then resolved to be appointed as liquidator on any subsequent liquidation, the relevant replacement office holder will be deemed to have been resolved to be appointed in his place
- 9. Where a replacement office holder is appointed, in substitution for an outgoing office holder, he or she shall act jointly and severally with their joint appointment holder, unless the outgoing office holder did not so act, in which case they shall act in the same capacity as the outgoing office holder previously did
- 10. In relation to the insolvency proceedings listed in the Schedules, and insofar as the Insolvency Act 1986 or the Insolvency Rules 1986 contains any requirement for advertisement, the requirement shall be dispensed with (subject to further order of the Court) Insofar as the Applicants are required by law to give any notice of the removal from office, the Replacement Office Holder is entitled to sign and send any such notice on their behalf.
