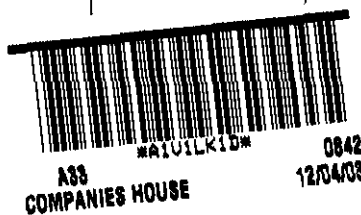

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ORDER OF THE COURT

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UPON the Petition of Peter Collins, June May, Sir Gerrard Neale, Sir Leonard Peach, Terence Plummer, Nicola Sawford, Gary Sheppard and Rodney Smith, the directors of Affinity Internet Holdings PLC ("the Company") presented to the Court on 7<sup>th</sup> April 2003.

UPON the Applicants by their Counsel undertaking to present the Petition herein forthwith and in any event before 4.00 pm on Monday 7<sup>th</sup> April 2003.

AND upon hearing counsel for the Petitioners  
And upon reading the evidence

IT IS ORDERED that during the period for which this Order is in force the affairs, business and property of the company be managed by the administrators hereinafter appointed pursuant to the provisions of section 8 of the Insolvency Act 1986 for the following purposes:

- (1) The survival of the Company and the whole or any part of its undertaking as a going concern.
- (2) A more advantageous realisation of the Company's assets than would be effected on a winding up.

AND it is ordered that there be a review of this Order at the expiry of the period of three months from the date of this Order or earlier in the event that the total aggregate of the Administrators' fees (including legal and valuation and all other professional fees) reaches £100,000 plus VAT.

AND it is further ordered that:

Vivian Bairstow and Nicholas Hood of Begbies Traynor, 1-2 Raymond Buildings, Grays Inn, London WC1R 5NR be appointed joint administrators of the company. Either joint administrator may exercise all of the powers of an administrator conferred by this Order and the Insolvency Act 1986 individually as well as jointly.

AND the Court being satisfied on the evidence before it that the EC Regulation does apply in relation to these proceedings and that these proceedings are main proceedings within the meaning of the EC Regulation.

AND it is ordered that the costs of the petition (including the costs of the r.2.2 report) herein are to be paid as an expense of the administration.

AND it is ordered that a redacted of the witness statement of June Carol May dated 7<sup>th</sup> April 2003 omitting paragraph 24 thereof and Exhibit D thereto shall be available for inspection and that a full copy of the said witness statement including the said Exhibit shall be provided in a sealed envelope and left on the Court file which will not be open to inspection.
