

#### **Progress Report:**

 You will recall that I, Kikis Kallis was appointed Administrator in this matter on 16<sup>th</sup> December 2003.

- I am obliged to report to creditors every six months to advise on the progress of the administration. This is my first report in this regard covering the period from my appointment to 15<sup>th</sup> June 2004.
- Attached is an abstract of my receipts and payments account for the period from 16<sup>th</sup> December 2003 to 15<sup>th</sup> June 2004. You will note that there have been no receipts and payments during this period.
- As you are aware a meeting of creditors was held on 30<sup>th</sup> March 2004 at which my proposals were approved by creditors. It was anticipated that an offer would be made for the company's business shortly thereafter.
- I am pleased to advise that an initial offer has been received but this has yet to be formalised and I am not therefore in a position at the moment to provide you with further details in this regard. I am hopeful however that matters will be formalised shortly.
- The only other asset the company has was debtors overseas. These debtors are based all over Africa and have proved very difficult to pursue. Without funds to take any further action it has not been possible to purse these further. From the work carried out to date it would appear that if these debtors were pursued further they themselves would be insolvent and have to be wound up accordingly.
- From the above the only potentially realisable asset is the sale of the business structure. If this is successful there will be a return to creditors and it may be a matter of placing the company into liquidation in order to make the necessary

realisations and pay creditors a dividend in due course. Obviously I will report to you further in this regard in due course.

- If the offer does not materialise there will be no realisations in this matter and there will thus be no distribution to creditors and the case will be closed accordingly.
- Creditor claims in this matter are in excess of £2 million. To date these claims have not been adjudicated since there are no funds to hand. If realisations are made and a distribution to creditors is payable they will be reviewed at that time.
- Finally I would advise that the time spent by my staff and I on this matter from 16<sup>th</sup> December 2003 to date totals 152.75 hours amounting to a cost of £28,360.75 at an average rate of £185.66 per hour. Due to the insufficiency of funds all my work in progress remains unpaid along with my disbursements. Given that there are no funds and hence no payment has been made to me from the administration I have not provided a breakdown of costs at this time. I would however advise that £3,000 has been received from Robert Soteriou of Messrs Soteriou Banerji, the company's former accountant. The purpose of the payment was as a contribution against the legal costs incurred in putting the administration in place and my firms pre administration work in progress.
