This is my annual progress report under section 92A of the Insolvency Act ('the Act') and Rules 18.3 and 18.7 of the Insolvency (England and Wales) Rules 2016 ('the Rules'). Statutory Information

The Company went into Liquidation on 15 December 2017. The current Joint Liquidators are Malcolm Cohen and Matthew Chadwick and they can be contacted at the above address. Matthew Chadwick was appointed Joint Liquidator on 7 May 2021 and in substitution of Edward Kerr who passed away in November 2020.

The company registration number is 03729720. The Company was incorporated on 10 March 1999. The Company had no former names in the 12 months before Liquidation.
