1 Accounting policies

1.1 Accounting convention

The financial statements are prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective April 2008).

The financial statements have been prepared under the going concern basis which assumes that the company will continue in operational existence for the foreseeable future. During the year ended 30 November 2013 the company made a loss before taxation of £11,660 and at that date its liabilities exceeded its assets by £88,645. If the company was unable to continue in operational existence for the foreseeable future, adjustments would have to be made to reduce the balance sheet values to their recoverable amount and to provide for future liabilities that may arise and to reclassify fixed assets as current assets.

The directors believe that it is appropriate for the financial statements to be prepared on a going concern basis, given the continued support of the holding company.

1.2 Turnover

Turnover represents amounts receivable for goods and services net of VAT and trade discounts.

1.3 Tangible fixed assets and depreciation

Tangible fixed assets are stated at cost less depreciation. Depreciation is provided at rates calculated to write off the cost less estimated residual value of each asset over its expected useful life, as follows:

Plant and machinery	50% reducing balance
Motor vehicles	33% straight line

1.4 Deferred taxation

Deferred taxation is provided in full in respect of taxation deferred by timing differences between the treatment of certain items for taxation and accounting purposes. The deferred tax balance has not been discounted.

1.5 Comparative period

The comparative financial reporting period covered the 18 month period ending 30 November 2012.
