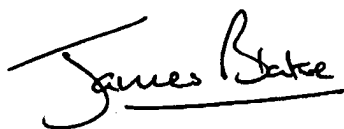
RESPECTIVE RESPONSIBILITIES OF DIRECTOR AND AUDITOR

Basis of accounting
