**ORDER**

**UPON** the Application of Simon James Michaels and Christopher Kim Rayment, the Joint Administrators (the "Administrators") of Telecentric Solutions Limited (the "Company")

**AND UPON HEARING** Counsel for the Administrators

**AND UPON** reading the Witness Statement of Simon James Michael and exhibit "SJM1"

**AND UPON** the Administrators undertaking by their Counsel to restore the application before the Court in the event that the resolutions for the winding-up of the Company as referred to in paragraph 2 below are not passed at the relevant meetings.

**IT IS DIRECTED THAT** the Administrators do pay into a designated trust account in the name of the Company the sum requisite to satisfy the total amount of the preferential claims against the Company as agreed between the Administrators and the creditors who would otherwise be entitled to rank as preferential creditors for their claims in the event that an order for the compulsory winding-up of the Company was made immediately upon the discharge of the administration order (the "Preferential Creditors") and that such sum be held for the purpose of paying the Preferential Creditors.

**AND IT IS ORDERED THAT**

- (1) The Administration Order of Mr Justice Lloyd dated 1 April 2003 (the "Administration Order") be discharged pursuant to section 18(3) of the Insolvency Act 1986 (the "Act") conditional upon and immediately prior to the members and creditors of the Company resolving to place the Company into creditors' voluntary liquidation.
- (2) The Administrators and each of them be absolutely and unconditionally released from all liabilities in respect of their acts or omissions in the administration and otherwise in relation to their conduct as administrators of the Company with effect from 30 days after the filing of their final receipts and payments account, save in respect of any claim notified to the Applicants by that date.
- (3) The costs of and occasioned by this application, including legal and accountancy costs, be paid as an expense of the Administration.
