

Receipts and payments (Appendix 1a – 1h)

There have been no receipts or payments during the liquidations

Tax

Following their appointment, the Joint Liquidators sought and received confirmation from HM Revenue and Customs ("HMRC") that the Companies had no outstanding corporation tax returns or liabilities, that HMRC would not raise enquiries into any pre or post liquidation periods and that it had no objection to the Joint Liquidators calling the final meetings of members to conclude the liquidations

HMRC have also confirmed that the Companies have no outstanding VAT liabilities

Creditors

The Companies had no known creditors. A notice to creditors to prove their claims in the liquidations was advertised in The London Gazette and The Times newspaper on 9 September 2014.

A claim for £404 was received from British Gas on CSM Limited although this was later withdrawn. The claim should not have been against CSM Limited and British Gas confirmed that they had made a mistake with the company name.

A potential claim for £217,000 was received from Lidolo Pty Limited c/o Keith Cleland on Hartley Computer UK Limited in respect of a loan account. Following correspondence with the Joint Liquidators, in which it was shown that the loan account appeared to have been settled at the time of the acquisition of Hartley International Limited by the Sage group, the deadline for claims expired and no formal claim was received from Lidolo Pty Limited.

No other claims were received.

Property

A search of the Index of Proprietors' Names at HM Land Registry (in both a Company's present and former names) revealed no titles in any of the Companies' names.

Distributions

On Hartley Computer UK Limited, a group debtor of £600 due from Sage (UK) Limited was distributed in specie to Hartley International Limited

On KCS Connect Limited, a group debtor of £1 due from Sage (UK) Limited was distributed in specie to KCS Global Holdings Limited

On KCS Global Limited, a group debtor of £1 due from Sage (UK) Limited was distributed in specie to KCS Global Holdings Limited

On KCS Management Systems Limited, a group debtor of £1 due from Sage (UK) Limited was distributed in specie to KCS Global Holdings Limited

On Taxsoft Limited, a group debtor of £1 due from Sage (UK) Limited was distributed in specie to Quantec (Holdings) Limited

CSM Limited, Professional Accountants Computer Software Limited, and Promis Software Limited had no debtors and therefore no distributions were required for these companies

Joint Liquidators' remuneration and expenses

Written resolutions were passed on 27 August 2014 that the remuneration of the Joint Liquidators be fixed at their normal charging rates according to the time properly spent by them and members of their staff in attending to matters arising in the winding up of the Companies

The Joint Liquidators' fees and disbursements are being met by Sage (UK) Limited and further details have been provided

The Joint Liquidators are required to advise members of their right to challenge the basis of the Joint Liquidators' remuneration pursuant to Rule 4.148C of the Insolvency Rules 1986 if they consider it is excessive

Final meetings

The final meetings of members were held at 11am, 11 05am, 11 10am, 11 15am, 11 20am, 11 25am, 11 30am, and 11 35am on 18 March 2015. The meetings were held pursuant to Section 94 of the Insolvency Act 1986 and their purpose was to receive an account showing the manner in which the winding up of the Companies has been conducted and the property of the Companies disposed of, and of hearing any explanations given by the Joint Liquidators


There were no resolutions proposed at the meetings
