Activities

The company continued its objective of drawing attention to the dangers of low level radioactive discharges by maintaining a web site, by supporting independent research and analysis, by supporting appeals against refusal of Service Pensions for British nuclear weapons test veterans, and by participating in the stakeholder Forum of the Department of Business, Energy and Industrial Strategy. No editions of the Campaign's journal *Radioactive Times* were published. No individual grant larger than £2400 was obtained.

Financial Results

The Company is not trading for profit.

The accounts have been delivered in accordance with the provisions applicable to companies subject to the small companies regime.

The results of the year are set out in the Income and Expenditure and the Balance Sheet attached hereto.

At 1 September 2016 the Campaign held funds of £ 4352. Expenditure for the year was greater than income by a sum of £ 1350, leaving a surplus at 31 August 2017 of £3002.

The directors will continue to operate the company within the cash resources available to them.
