UPON THE PETITION of 7C (Pembroke) Limited (the "**Company**") acting by its Joint Administrators Simon Charles Morris, Andrew Lawrence Hosking and David Robert Thurgood, all of Grant Thornton UK LLP, Grant Thornton House, Melton Street, London, NW1 2EP (together the "**Joint Administrators**")

AND UPON HEARING Counsel for the Company

AND UPON READING the evidence recorded on the Court file as having been read

AND UPON the Court being satisfied on the evidence before it that the EC Regulation does apply and that these proceedings are main proceedings as defined in Article 3 of the EC Regulation

IT IS ORDERED that

- 1 The Administration Order made in relation to the Company by Mr Justice Peter Smith on 30 November 2002 be discharged pursuant to section 18(2)(a) of the Insolvency

Act 1986, on the grounds that the purposes specified in the administration orders have been achieved as far as possible, or are incapable of achievement,

- 2 Pursuant to section 20 of the Insolvency Act 1986 the Joint Administrators and each of them be absolutely and unconditionally released from all liabilities in respect of their acts or omissions in the administration or otherwise in relation to their conduct as administrators of the Companies with effect from 28 days of their final receipts and payments account being filed with the Court save in respect of any claim notified to the Joint Administrators by that date
- 3 7C (Pembroke) Limited (company registration number 03891960) be compulsorily wound up by the Court under the provisions of the Insolvency Act 1986
- 4 The requirement to advertise the Petition be dispensed with
- 5 The costs of the Petition be paid as an expense of the administration
