1 INTRODUCTION

- 1.1 This Report is addressed to the creditors of A1 Grand Prix Operations Limited and incorporates the Administrator's proposals. These proposals are sent to creditors pursuant to Paragraph 49 of Schedule B1 of the Insolvency Act 1986 ("the Act").
- 1.2 On 06 October 2009 pursuant to Paragraph 12(1)(a) and 12(1)(c) of Schedule B1 of the Insolvency Act 1986, I, Timothy Bramston of Griffins was appointed Administrator by the High Court of Justice following an application that I made as Liquidator.

2 EVENTS LEADING UP TO THE MAKING OF THE ADMINISTRATION ORDER

- 2.1 The company was incorporated on 28 January 2000 as Spirit Racing Services Limited and later changed its name to A1 Grand Prix Operations Limited on 24 December 2004.
- 2.2 On 12 May 2009 a petition was presented by Neil Shakespeare & Steve Middleton t/as Shakespeare Engineering and Components to wind the Company up.
- 2.3 Subsequent to the petition, on 24 June 2009 a Winding up order was made against the Company and I was subsequently appointed Liquidator on 21 July 2009 by a Secretary of State appointment.
- 2.4 On 18 September 2009, I made an application to Court to place the Company into Administration in order to preserve the assets from being dissipated due to the many competing claims presented by creditors in order to have the possibility of selling the assets as a whole to maximise realisations for creditors.

3 STATEMENT OF AFFAIRS AND STATUTORY INFORMATION

3.1 I have attached the Statement of affairs as at the date of the Administration order and can be viewed at Appendix III

- The net book value of the Company's fixed assets and stock per the Company's accounting records as at 30 April 2009 were £8,651,078.
- 3.3 The total value of assets available for creditors is yet to be decided once ongoing issues relating to ownership of the motorcars has been resolved.

4 ACHIEVING THE PURPOSE OF THE ADMINISTRATION

- 4.1 In accordance with Paragraph 3 of Schedule B1, the purpose of an administration consists of three possible objectives, and I now address the progress that has been made in this respect.
 - (a) Rescue the company as Going concern basis The Company was formed to facilitate the running of the A1 Grand Prix Motor racing World Series. Its primary role was to provide logistical support to the series in arranging for the cars and race teams to be at each race location. Providing tools and parts to each team upon their request by purchase orders from third parties and invoicing the teams directly. It is currently unlikely that it would be possible to rescue the Company unless funds are provided by its holding company to enable Creditors to be paid in full.
 - (b) Achieving a better result for creditors as a whole than would be likely if the company were Wound up (without first being in administration) I believe that this would be most beneficial to creditors as it allows an even and fair distribution of assets to all creditors whilst preserving assets from being dissipated by creditors with competing claims. In particular I believe the assets are capable of better realisation if sold as a whole to enable use in a race series.
 - (c) Realising property in order to make a distribution to one or more secured or preferential creditors As far as I am aware all of the company's liabilities will rank as unsecured non-preferential claims and therefore this objective is not applicable.
- 4.2 Once the process of realising assets and distributing to all creditors has been completed, I propose to apply for dissolution of the Company. However, if realisations become protracted say if litigation is proposed, I will place the Company into creditors voluntary liquidation.
- 5 MANAGEMENT OF THE COMPANY'S AFFAIRS SINCE THE ADMINISTRATOR'S APPOINTMENT

Initial Actions:

- 5.1 Upon the Administration Order being made in the High Court of Justice, I have advertised my appointment in accordance with para 46(2)(a) sch. B1 Insolvency Act 1986 and Rule 2.27(1) Insolvency Rules 1986.
- 5.2 I have convened an initial meeting of creditors for 30 October 2009 at 10.00am at Griffins, Tavistock House South, Tavistock Square, London WC1H 9LG.

6 CREDITORS CLAIMS

6.1 Total creditors in administration amount to approximately £99,581,350.00 but I expect this figure to rise as many claims are yet to be received. I have attached a list of creditors at Appendix VIII.

7 EC REGULATIONS ON INSOLVENCY PROCEEDINGS

7.1 I confirm that the EC Regulations apply and that these proceedings are main proceedings within the meaning of the Regulation because the company's centre of main interests is in England.

8 POSSIBLE OUTCOMES FOR THE COMPANY AND CREDITORS

- 8.1 The Insolvency Act 1986 and Insolvency Rules 1986 provide a variety of options regarding the possible exit routes for the company from administration, being a Company Voluntary Arrangement, Liquidation of Dissolution of the company.
- 8.2 I do anticipate that there will be funds available for distribution to the unsecured creditors and will make an application to court to enable me to do this when I am in a position to make a distribution.
- 8.3 I propose to then exit the Administration by filing for the dissolution of the Company however, should the court refuse to sanction distribution to unsecured creditors in the Administration, I shall seek to exit the Administration through Creditors Voluntary Liquidation.

9 ADMINISTRATOR'S REMUNERATION

- 9.1 Under the terms of the Insolvency Rules 1986, the Administrator is obliged to fix his remuneration in accordance with Rule 2.106(2)(b). This permits remuneration to be fixed by a percentage of the value of the assets with which the Administrator has to deal, or alternatively by reference to the time the Administrator and his staff have spent attending to matters in the Administration. In respect of this Administration, I ask creditors to approve my remuneration on a time cost basis and attached at Appendix II is a schedule that summarises the time that has been spent in administering this Administration from 06 October 2009 to 08 October 2009. This shows a total of £5,510.00 which represents a total of 18.75 hours at an average charge-out rate of £293.87 per hour.
- 9.2 I attach, for your information, a Creditors' Guide to Administrator's Fees, together with a document which outlines my firm's policy relating to fees and disbursements.
- 9.3 In respect of the Liquidation and as directed under the Court Order dated 06 October 2009, creditors are able to agree the basis of my remuneration as Liquidator. I ask creditors to approve my remuneration on the basis of Rule 4.127(1)(a) Insolvency Rules 1986 being time properly given by the

Insolvency Practitioner (as Liquidator) and his staff in attending to matters arising in the winding up.

9.4 Please be advised that the time costs for the administration of the Liquidation were misquoted in my last report as £63,020.83. This error occurred for the reason that the time properly spent had not been validated in time for the production of my report dated 29 September 2009 and subsequently was not included. The actual time costs for the Liquidation at that date were £92,013.75 and currently stand at £105,092.08. I have attached a SIP 9 summary for your attention for both periods at Appendix VII.

10 STATEMENT OF PROPOSAL UNDER PARAGRAGH 49 OF SCHEDULE B1 OF THE INSOLVENCY ACT 1986

- 10.1 The Administrator makes the following proposals for achieving the purpose of the Administration. These proposals will be considered by a Meeting of Creditors convened pursuant to Paragraph 51 of Schedule B1 of the Insolvency Act 1986.
- 10.2 Formal proposals the Administrator proposes:
- 10.3 That the company exits the Administration by filing for the dissolution of the Company.
- 10.4 The Liquidator shall have the right to an indemnity out of the assets of the Company in respect of his acts as Liquidator.
- 10.5 To establish a Creditors Committee to assist the Administrator with the Administration.
- 10.6 If no Committee is appointed, to agree the remuneration charged by the liquidator in respect of him acting as liquidator in accordance with rule 4.127(2)(b) of the Insolvency Rules 1986 being time properly given by the Insolvency Practitioner (as Liquidator) and his staff in attending to matters arising in the winding up save that where reference is made to creditors or to a liquidation committee, the same shall be read to be the creditors within the administration and to any creditors committee formed within the administration.
- 10.7 The expenses of the liquidation are to be paid out of the assets of the Company.
- 10.7.1 The basis of the Administrator's remuneration be by reference to the time properly given by the Insolvency practitioner (as administrator) and his staff in attending to the matters arising in the administration.
- 10.7.2 Agree the basis of the former Liquidator's remuneration by reference to the time properly given by the Insolvency practitioner (as liquidator) and his staff in attending to the matters arising in the liquidation.
- 10.7.3 It is not my firm's policy to draw Category 2 disbursements as defined by SIP 9. These are expenses payable to IPs for the overhead incurred by their own firm in carrying out insolvency work.

10.7.4 That in the event that the Administrator forms the opinion that the Administration is likely to exceed twelve months, he will apply to Court pursuant to Paragraph 76(2) of the Act to extend the period of the Administration.

GRIFFINS POLICY ON DISBURSEMENTS AND CHARGEOUT RATES

INTRODUCTION

This note applies where a licensed insolvency practitioner in the firm is acting as an office holder of an insolvent estate and seeks creditor approval to make a separate charge by way of expenses or disbursements to recover the cost of facilities provided by the firm. Best practice guidance¹ requires that such charges should be disclosed to those who are responsible for approving his remuneration, together with an explanation of how those charges are made up and the basis on which they are arrived at.

DEFINITIONS

Best practice guidance¹ classifies expenses into two broad categories:

- Category 1 expenses (approval not required) specific expenditure that is directly related to a particular insolvency case, where the cost of the expense incurred is referable against an independent external suppliers' invoice or published tariff of charges;
- Category 2 expenses (approval required) all other items of expenditure:
 - Which cannot, or cannot easily, be directly related to a particular insolvency case because there is an element of shared or allocated cost; and/or
 - Where the cost of the expense incurred is an estimated, utilised cost with the estimate based on external costs or opportunity costs.

CHARGING POLICY

- Category 1 expenses (approval not required) with the exception of any items referred to below, all such items are re-charged to the case as they are incurred.
- Category 2 expenses (approval required)
 - (A) The following items of expenditure are re-charged as described:
 - Car mileage is re-charged at the Inland Revenue authorised rate of 40 pence per mile for the first 10,000 miles and 25 pence per mile thereafter;
 - (B) The following items of expenditure will normally be treated as general office overheads not subject to a re-charge:
 - Telephone and facsimile;
 - Printing and photocopying;
 - Storage of books and records;
 - Postage and stationery.

A recharge may be made, however, where the precise cost to the case can be determined because the item satisfies the test of a Category 1 expense.
