2. DIRECTOR'S ADVANCES, CREDITS AND GUARANTEES

During the year, P F Jenkins increased his loan to the company. As at 30 June 2018 the company owed him £19,352 (2017: £16,352). This balance represented the maximum amount outstanding during the year and the loan is interest free and repayable on demand.

During the year the company paid P F Jenkins rent, under a formal license agreement, for utilising space within his home. This amounted to £2,400 in the year to 30 June 2018 (2017: £2,400).

The company is entitled to exemption from audit under Section 477 of the Companies Act 2006 for the year ended 30 June 2018.

The members have not required the company to obtain an audit of its financial statements for the year ended 30 June 2018 in accordance with Section 476 of the Companies Act 2006.
