1 Accounting policies

1.1 Accounting convention

The financial statements are prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective January 2015).

Although there is an excess of liabilities over assets amounting to £4,015, the director has a loan account balance owing to him of £8000 that is included within creditors due after more than one year. The director has stated he will continue to support the company by not repaying this loan to himself during the 12 months from the date of the approval of these accounts. For this reason the financial statements have been prepared on the going concern basis although no provision has been made for any adjustments that would result should the director withdraw his support.

1.2 Compliance with accounting standards

The financial statements are prepared in accordance with applicable United Kingdom Accounting Standards (United Kingdom Generally Accepted Accounting Practice), which have been applied consistently (except as otherwise stated).

1.3 Turnover

Turnover represents amounts receivable for goods and services net of VAT and trade discounts.

1.4 Tangible fixed assets and depreciation

Tangible fixed assets are stated at cost less depreciation. Depreciation is provided at rates calculated to write off the cost less estimated residual value of each asset over its expected useful life, as follows:
