1 Introduction

- 1 1 Following the appointment of Anthony Flynn and myself as joint administrators of the Company by the director on 22 April 2008, I am submitting our proposals pursuant to paragraph 49(1) of Schedule B1 to the Insolvency Act 1986 for achieving the objectives of the administrations
- 1.2 This report contains the information required by Rule 2 33 of the Insolvency Rules 1986.
- 1.3 In accordance with paragraph 100 (2) of Schedule B1 to the Insolvency Act 1986 the functions of the joint administrators are to be exercised by any or all of them.

3 Background to the administrators' appointment

- 3 1 Grant Thornton UK ILP (the firm) was first consulted by the Company's director on 4 March 2008 Prior to the consultation, neither I nor the firm had any dealings or involvement with the Company or the director
- 3 2 The firm carried out a brief investigation into the Company's affairs. Our findings in respect of the financial position of the Company can be summarised as follows
 - The Company was insolvent on a balance sheet basis with net liabilities, as at 12 March 2008, of circa £342,000
 - HM Revenue & Customs (HMRC) was due circa £507,000 in relation to VAT for the
 quarters ending 31 October 2007 and 31 January 2008 On 10 March 2008 HMRC
 wrote to the Company formally demanding payment of the outstanding VAT liability
 within 7 days
 - In addition HMRC was also due circa £491,000 for outstanding PAYE/NIC for the period December 2007 to March 2008
- Administration was the correct procedure in this case as it would enable an immediate appointment and give protection from creditors. On 22 April 2008 the directors made the direct appointment of administrators in accordance with paragraph 22 of schedule B1 of the Insolvency Act 1986.
- 3 4 The objectives of the administration are to achieve a better result for the Company's creditors as a whole than would be likely if the Company were wound up and to realise property in order to make a distribution to one or more secured or preferential creditors

4 Assets and liabilities

Statement of affairs

41 The director has been requested to prepare a statement of affairs of the Company, but has not yet done so An estimate of the financial position of the Company is attached at Appendix A, together with a list of the names and addresses of the creditors, the amount of their debts and details of any security held

- 4 2 I must note that the schedule of creditors does not include amounts due to the agency drivers, for the purpose of this report I have estimated their combined claims to be circa £60,000
- 4.3 In addition, the statement does not account for the costs of the administration process

Principle Assets

- 4.4 The Company's principal assets at the date of appointment were as follows
 - Goodwill
 - Debtor Ledger
 - Chattel Assets (office furniture, equipment, vehicle and trailers)
 - Leases to 10 properties

Secured Creditor

- 4.5 The Company's debtors were financed through a factoring arrangement with Venture Finance Plc (Venture) Venture holds a debenture containing fixed and floating charges dated 27 February 2004
- 4.6 In addition, HSBC Bank Plc (the Bank) holds a debenture dated 21 June 2006 in respect of an outstanding loan of £203,000
- 47 It is understood that there is a deed of priority between Venture and the Bank, and that Venture has priority

5 CONDUCT OF THE ADMINISTRATION

Appointment of professional advisors

- 5.1 On appointment I instructed the following advisors
 - Jardine Lloyd Thompson to arrange appropriate insurance cover
 - Ashfords to act as my solicitors
 - GoIndustry (GI) were appointed as my agents and assisted with valuation of the Company's assets

Realisation of assets

Sale of the Business

During our initial meeting the director expressed an interest in purchasing the business and assets of the Company Shortly thereafter an offer of £100,000 for the Company's assets (excluding the debtors) was received from PL Workforce Employment Services Limited (PLS), a company set up by the director

- The offer of £100,000 was made on the basis that £25,000 would be paid on the date of completion, £18,750 paid within one month of appointment and the remaining £56,250 paid in three equal instalments after 30 days, 60 days and 90 days. This would also be subject to the director providing a personal guarantee
- Prior to receiving the offer GI undertook a desktop valuation of the Company's assets valuing the chattel assets at £38,000 in-situ and £23,000 ex-situ GI advised that the leasehold properties had no value
- 5 5 We identified the following advantages of completing an immediate sale of the business
 - Trading the business in administration whilst it was marketed for sale was not possible for the following reasons
 - Funding was not available to finance the cash flow which would be required in order to trade
 - Due to the geographical spread of customers and temporary staff it would have proved difficult and expensive to manage trading and additional professional costs would be high
 - There would be a risk of losing key salaried staff
 - The offer was higher than GI's in-situ and ex-situ valuations of the assets
 - The debtor ledger of circa £1,188,000 would be protected by the business continuing to operate as key customer relationships would be maintained and the provision of temporary staff to the customers would continue without disruption
 - The Company's salaried employees would transfer to PLS under the Transfer of Undertakings (Protection of Employment) Regulations 2006, which would preserve their jobs and eliminate potential preferential claims
- No other interested parties were identified during our initial investigations and accordingly a sale of the business and assets to PLS was completed immediately following my appointment

Debtors

- As noted, the sale to PLS did not include the Company's debtors, which at the date of appointment amounted to circa £1,188,000
- To date £512,306 has been collected and Venture's debt of £258,513, including its termination fee and charges, has now been repaid
- 5 9 As at 13 July 2008 I have received £135,000 surplus debtor receipts from Venture and a further £5,000 directly
- 5 10 For the purpose of the estimated outcome statement I have provided for total debtor realisations of £800,000

Receipts and Payments

5 11 My receipts and payments accounts covering the period 22 April 2008 to 13 June 2008 is attached at Appendix B

6 Estimated outcome for creditors

Secured Creditors

- 6.1 As noted above, Venture's debt as at the date of appointment has been repaid in full
- 62 Based on current information, I also anticipate that the Bank will be repaid in full

Preferential Creditors

6.3 The contracts of employment for all of the Company's employees were transferred to PLS following the sale. As a consequence of this there are no preferential claims

Unsecured Creditors

- 6.4 The Company records indicate unsecured claims at the date of appointment total circa £1,349,000
- 6 5 I currently anticipate that there will be sufficient funds to enable a dividend to be made to the Company's unsecured creditors, although this will be dependant on final asset realisations, costs, and the level of claims received

7 Proposals for achieving the objectives of the administration

- 7 1 The joint administrators propose to remain in office for the time being to deal with the realisation of the Company's debtors and other assets, the distribution of surplus funds in the correct statutory priority and to complete their statutory duties
- 7 2 It is proposed that the administration will end by the Company going into Creditors Voluntary Liquidation, or if there are no monies available for unsecured creditors, by the dissolution of the Company
- 7 3 If the Company is placed into Creditors Voluntary Liquidation it is proposed that Anthony Flynn and Nigel Morrison will be appointed joint liquidators. However, creditors may nominate a different liquidator providing nomination to that effect is received before the approval of these proposals.

8 Administrators' remuneration and disbursements

- The creditors committee, if appointed, should determine the basis of the joint administrators' remuneration. If no committee is appointed, a resolution of the creditors will be required.
- 8 2 Background information regarding the fees of administrators can be found at http://www.insolvency-practitioners org.uk (navigate via 'Technical' to 'Creditors Guides to Fees') Alternatively I will supply this information by post on request

- 8 3 The joint administrators will request that their remuneration be calculated according to the time properly given by the joint administrators and their staff in attending to matters arising in the administration and the joint administrators are authorised to draw such remuneration on account
- The joint administrators will charge out of pocket expenses at cost. Mileage is charged at standard rates which comply with HM Revenue and Customs limits or AA recommended rates. VAT is added to disbursement charges as necessary.
- Payments of the joint administrators' remuneration and disbursements are to be met from funds held in the administration in priority to the claims of creditors, and, after approval of the basis, the joint administrators may draw sums on account
- Time costs and disbursements to date amount to £28,057 and £192 respectfully Further details, including a breakdown by category of staff and work done will be given to the creditors' committee, if appointed, or made available at the creditors' meeting
