1 Introduction and Statutory Information

- I, David Clements, together with my partner Paul Boyle, of Harrisons Business Recovery and Insolvency (London) Limited, Suite 2D Queens Chambers, 5 John Dalton Street, Manchester M2 6ET, was appointed as Joint Liquidator of Roger Miles Planning Limited ('the Company') on 28 July 2020. This report provides an update on the progress in the liquidation for year ended 27 July 2021 ('the Period').

2 Progress of the Liquidation

- 2.1 At Appendix A, I have provided an account of my Receipts and Payments for the Period from 28 July 2020 to 27 July 2021, together with a comparison to the Declaration of Solvency values.
- 2.2 The sum of £71,651.55 has been realised from the Company's bank account held at National Westminster Bank plc. The sum of £37,606.09 has been realised from a corporation tax refund from HMRC.
- **3** Distributions to Members
- 3.1 The following cash distributions to members have been made since the date of my appointment:
 - A first interim distribution of £64,500.00 representing £21,500.00 per each £1 share on 13 October 2020.
 - A second interim distribution of £37,575.00 representing £12,525.00 per each £1 share on 10 November 2020.

4 Joint Liquidators' Remuneration

- 4.1 Members approved that the basis of the Joint Liquidators' remuneration be fixed by reference to the time properly spent by them and their staff in managing the Liquidation. This remuneration was limited to a maximum charge of £2500.00 plus VAT plus disbursements.
- 4.2 My time costs for the Period from 28 July 2020 to 27 July 2021 are £9525.00. This represents 40.7 hours at an average rate of £234.03 per hour. Even though my remuneration is based upon a fixed fee as outlined at 4.1 above, for the further information of members attached at Appendix B is a Time Analysis which provides details of the activity costs incurred by staff grade during this period in respect of the costs fixed by reference to time properly spent in managing the Liquidation. I would confirm that £2500.00 will be drawn on account of these costs including the Declaration of Solvency Fee of £2500.00 and that there will be no further drawings in this regard.

Staff allocation and the use of subcontractors
