

Receipts and payments (Appendix 1a – 1i)

There have been no receipts or payments during the liquidations

Tax

Following their appointment, the Joint Liquidators sought and received confirmation from HM Revenue and Customs ("HMRC") that the Companies had no outstanding corporation tax returns or liabilities, that HMRC would not raise enquiries into any pre or post liquidation periods and that it had no objection to the Joint Liquidators calling the final meetings of members to conclude the liquidations

For completeness, HMRC have also confirmed that the Companies have no outstanding VAT liabilities

Creditors

The Companies had no known creditors. A notice to creditors to prove their claims in the liquidations was advertised in The London Gazette and The Times newspaper on 13 August 2014 and no claims were received.

Property

A search of the Index of Proprietors' Names at HM Land Registry (in both a Company's present and former names) revealed no titles in any of the Companies' names.

Distributions

The declaration of solvency of Advanced Paypoint Solutions Limited showed group debtors of £1 due from Sage (UK) Limited. The group debtor was actually £200 rather than £1. This £200 was distributed in specie to George Stamford Limited.

Apex 24 com Limited had £2 of group debtors due from Apex Software International Limited. This was distributed in specie to Apex Software International Limited.

Apex Software Systems (UK) Limited had group debtors of £1 due from Apex Software International Limited. This was distributed in specie to Apex Software International Limited.

JCS Management Services Limited had group debtors of £2,000 due from Sage (UK) Limited. This was distributed in specie to KCS Global Holdings Limited.

Pro-Pay Limited had group debtors of £2 due from Sage (UK) Limited. This was distributed in specie to KCS Global Holdings Limited.

Protx Software Development Limited had group debtors of £1 due from Protx Group Limited. This was distributed in specie to Protx Group Limited.

VPDQ Limited had group debtors of £1 due from Sage (UK) Limited. This was distributed in specie to Protx Group Limited.

On B I Ventures Limited and IntelligentApps Limited, the declarations of solvency had balances of £0 and accordingly, no distributions were made for these two companies.

Joint Liquidators' remuneration and expenses

Written resolutions were passed on 1 August 2014 that the remuneration of the Joint Liquidators be fixed at their normal charging rates according to the time properly spent by them and members of their staff in attending to matters arising in the winding up of the Companies.

The Joint Liquidators' fees and disbursements are being met by Sage (UK) Limited and further details have been provided.

The Joint Liquidators are required to advise members of their right to challenge the basis of the Joint Liquidators' remuneration pursuant to Rule 4.148C of the Insolvency Rules 1986 if they consider it is excessive.

Final meetings

The final meetings of members were held at 11am, 11 05am, 11 10am, 11 15am, 11 20am, 11 25am, 11 30am, 11 35am, and 11 40am on 25 February 2015. The meetings were held pursuant to Section 94 of the Insolvency Act 1986 and their purpose was to receive an account showing the manner in which the winding up of the Companies has been conducted and the property of the Companies disposed of, and of hearing any explanations by the Joint Liquidators.

There were no resolutions proposed at the meetings.

The Joint Liquidators will file their final returns with the Registrar of Companies within 7 days of the final meetings. The Companies will be dissolved three months thereafter.


