By entering into the Intra-Group Funding Agreement the Subsidiary will make a loan of a maximum principal amount of £10,000,000 available to Guildford Acquisitionco Limited to enable Guildford Acquisitionco Limited to repay borrowings by it under the £90,000,000 senior facilities agreement dated 23 April 2007 between Guildford Acquisitionco Limited, Guildford Midco 2 Limited, Guildford Midco 1 Limited, Guildford Guaranteeco Limited and Guildford Bankco Limited and NIBC Bank N V London Branch as arranger, NIBC Bank N V Hague Branch as agent and NIBC Bank N V London Branch as security trustee (the "Senior Facilities Agreement") and a £20,000,000 mezzanine facility agreement dated 23 April 2007 between, amongst others, Guildford Acquisitionco Limited, Guildford Midco 2 Limited, Guildford Midco 1 Limited, Guildford Guaranteeco Limited and Guildford Bankco Limited as arranger, NIBC Bank N V Hague Branch as agent and NIBC Bank N V London Branch as security trustee (the "Mezzanine Facility Agreement") and to reduce or discharge liabilities incurred by it for the purpose of the Acquisition
