TRUSTEES' REPORT for the year ended 30 September 2015

The Trustees (who are also directors of the charity for the purposes of the Companies Act) present their annual report together with the financial statements of Tribos World Movement for Reconciliation (the company) for the ended 30 September 2015. The Trustees confirm that the Annual report and financial statements of the company comply with the current statutory requirements, the requirements of the company's governing document and the provisions of the Statement of Recommended Practice (SORP) "Accounting and Reporting by Charities" issued in March 2005.

STRUCTURE, GOVERNANCE AND MANAGEMENT

a. CONSTITUTION

The company is registered as a charitable company limited by guarantee and was set up by a Memorandum of Association on 29/09/2000.

The company is constituted under a Memorandum of Association dated 29/09/2000 and is a registered charity number 112530.

The principal object of the company is to promote the advancement of education through the study of reconciliation, peace and harmony amongst peoples.

b. METHOD OF APPOINTMENT OR ELECTION OF TRUSTEES

The management of the company is the responsibility of the Trustees who are elected and co-opted under the terms of the Articles of Association.

OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES

a. POLICIES AND OBJECTIVES

The company is a charity acting as an organisation to promote the objectives of Tribos World Movement for Reconciliation which are the advancement of education through the study of reconciliation, peace and harmony amongst peoples and the promotion of such reconciliation, peace and harmony amongst peoples. The trustees have had regard to the guidance given by the Charity Commission on Public benefit.

TRUSTEES' REPORT (continued) for the year ended 30 September 2015

ACHIEVEMENTS AND PERFORMANCE

a. GOING CONCERN

After making appropriate enquiries, the trustees have a reasonable expectation that the company has adequate resources to continue in operational existence for the foreseeable future. For this reason they continue to adopt the going concern basis in preparing the financial statements. Further details regarding the adoption of the going concern basis can be found in the Accounting Policies.

b. REVIEW OF ACTIVITIES

This academic year in November 2015, 36 students were enrolled as members of WMR at a very special Mass conducted by Fr. Joseph Karbo with Fr. Len Kofler and Fr. Thaddeus de Deckere as concelebrants. This ceremony came to pass at the end of the Conflict Management workshop, which took place 16th - 20th November 2015 inclusive.

During the workshop, which was conducted by Fr. Len Kofler, Wijnand Huijs and John Hunt, participants were introduced to the objectives, philosophy and values of WMR. Other topics covered included sources of conflict, power (authentic and inauthentic power) and conflict, steps to conflict resolution, assertiveness training, conflict and culture, forgiveness and reconciliation.

The new members were issued with a certificate of membership and a badge by Fr Len Kofler, after which they made a commitment to the aims and objectives of WMR. Fr. Len encouraged the new members to remain faithful to their commitment and become agents of reconciliation wherever they find themselves, but first, to begin with themselves.

FINANCIAL REVIEW

a. RESERVES POLICY

Unrestricted funds are being accumulated when they will be used to promote the charitable objectives to the full, with sufficient funds being maintained to cover current expenditure.

PLANS FOR THE FUTURE

a. FUTURE DEVELOPMENTS

Future plans remain to start up a group locally and to also get other Countries involved.

1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

1.1 BASIS OF PREPARATION OF FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention, with the exception of investments which are included at market value, and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective April 2008). The financial statements have been prepared in accordance with the Statement of Recommended Practice (SORP), 'Accounting and Reporting by Charities' published in March 2005, applicable accounting standards and the Companies Act 2006.

1.2 COMPANY STATUS

The company is a company limited by guarantee. The members of the company are the Trustees named on page 1. In the event of the company being wound up, the liability in respect of the guarantee is limited to £1 per member of the company.

1.3 FUND ACCOUNTING

General funds are unrestricted funds which are available for use at the discretion of the Trustees in furtherance of the general objectives of the company and which have not been designated for other purposes.

Investment income, gains and losses are allocated to the appropriate fund.

1.4 INCOMING RESOURCES

All incoming resources are included in the Statement of financial activities when the company has entitlement to the funds, certainty of receipt and the amount can be measured with sufficient reliability.

1.5 RESOURCES EXPENDED

Expenditure is accounted for on an accruals basis and has been included under expense categories that aggregate all costs for allocation to activities. Where costs cannot be directly attributed to particular activities they have been allocated on a basis consistent with the use of the resources.

Support costs are those costs incurred directly in support of expenditure on the objects of the company and include project management carried out at Headquarters.

1.6 TANGIBLE FIXED ASSETS AND DEPRECIATION

Tangible fixed assets are stated at cost less depreciation. Depreciation is provided at rates calculated to write off the cost of fixed assets, less their estimated residual value, over their expected useful lives on the following bases:
