The declaration of solvency, sworn by the directors prior to the commencement of the liquidation, showed a debt due from Enigma Travel Group Limited, the Company's immediate parent of £3,300,052 and debts due to Total Holidays Limited and Esprit Holidays Limited.

A liquidation distribution was received of £50,000 from the liquidation of Total Holidays Limited and £50,052 from the liquidation of Esprit Holidays Limited. The distributions were effected by set off against the inter-company debts due by the Company to Total Holidays Limited and Esprit Holidays Limited.

The Company has no known creditors. A notice to creditors to prove their claims in the liquidation was advertised in the London Gazette and the Times newspaper on 22 and 23 August 2013 respectively. No creditors were forthcoming as a result of these advertisements.

A search of the Index of Proprietors' Names at HM Land Registry proved negative.

Tax

All pre-liquidation corporation tax matters were handled by KPMG Tax who prepared and submitted all outstanding returns up to the date of the commencement of the liquidation to HM Revenue & Customs ("HMRC"). At the request of the Joint Liquidators HMRC subsequently confirmed that the Company had no outstanding corporation tax returns or liabilities, that it would not raise enquiries into any pre or post liquidation periods and that it had no objection to the Liquidators taking steps to bring the liquidation to a conclusion.

A similar assurance was sought and received from HMRC in respect of PAYE and VAT matters.

Distributions

On 8 December 2017 the Joint Liquidators declared a first and final distribution of the assets of the Company to Enigma Travel Group Limited, as the sole beneficial shareholder of the Company.

In the event, the Liquidators' remuneration has been paid by Hotelplan (U.K. Group) Limited and accordingly no detailed analysis is included in this report.
