1. Introduction

- 1.1 Edward Bines and Paul Williams of Kroll were appointed Joint Liquidators of the Company on the Appointment Date, by resolution of the Members.
- 1.2 The purpose of this report is to provide the Members with details of the progress of the Liquidation for the Reporting Period.

2. Progress of the Liquidation

2.1 The manner in which the affairs and business of the Company have been managed since the appointment of Joint Liquidators are set out below.

Intercompany Receivable

Parc D'Activites 1 GP Limited

- 2.2 According to the DoS, this entity has an intercompany receivable balance of £20 due from the member of this entity. This amount will be distributed in specie to the member of this entity following receipt of Corporation Tax and VAT clearance from HMRC.
- 2.3 There are no other known matters or assets to be dealt with.

D.U.K.E. Combined GP Limited and D.U.K.E. Properties (Marsh Mills) Limited

- 2.4 According to the DoS, these entities have no assets.
- 2.5 There are no other known matters or assets to be dealt with.

Creditors

- 2.6 The DoS reports that the Companies had no creditors.
- 2.7 In accordance with their statutory duty, the Joint Liquidators advertised the Liquidation in the London Gazette and requested that any creditors prove their debts.
- 2.8 No creditor claims have been received.

Other Matters

- 2.9 The Joint Liquidators have liaised with the Company and its tax agents to file the relevant preappointment Corporation Tax returns. These have been filed in the Reporting Period.
- 2.10 The Joint Liquidators have requested Corporation Tax and VAT clearance in the Reporting Period and once this has been received, steps will be taken to conclude the Liquidation.



Members' Distribution

2.11 As noted in paragraph 2.2 above, it is expected that there will be a distribution in specie to the Members of the intercompany receivable balance once Corporation Tax and VAT clearance are obtained from HMRC.

3. Joint Liquidators' Costs and Expenses

- 3.1 Written resolutions were passed on the Appointment Date that the remuneration of the Joint Liquidators be fixed at their charging rates according to the time properly spent by them and members of their staff in attending to matters arising in the winding up of the Company.
- 3.2 The Joint Liquidators have been paid directly by another group entity and accordingly no detailed analysis is included in this report.
- 3.3 There are no expenses incurred during the Reporting Period.

4. Joint Liquidators' Receipts and Payments Account

4.1 Detailed receipts and payments accounts for the Reporting Period are shown at Appendix 1. There are nil balances in the Liquidation estates.

Appendix 2

STATEMENT OF MEMBERS' RIGHTS

Rule numbers refer to Insolvency (England & Wales) Rules 2016 (as amended) Section numbers refer to Insolvency Act 1986

Members have the right to request information from the Liquidator under rule 18.9

Members of the company with at least 5% of the total voting rights of all the members having the right to vote at general meetings of the company and any member with the permission of the court may make a written request to the Liquidator for further information concerning remuneration or expenses. Such a request must be made within 21 days of receipt of this report and a response will be provided within 14 days of receipt of the request.

Members have recourse to court, application to be made within 21 days of the Liquidator giving reasons for not providing all the information requested or the expiry of the 14 days within which the Liquidator must respond to a request

Members have the right to challenge the Liquidator's remuneration and expenses under rule 18.34

Members of the company with at least 10% of the total voting rights of all the members having the right to vote at general meetings of the company and any member with the permission of the court, may make an application to court on the grounds that the remuneration charged or expenses incurred are excessive and/or that the basis fixed for the Liquidator's remuneration is inappropriate. The application to court must be made no later than eight weeks after receipt of the Progress Report where the charging of the remuneration or the incurring of expenses in question occurs.
