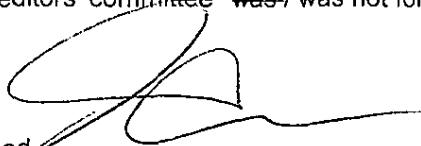

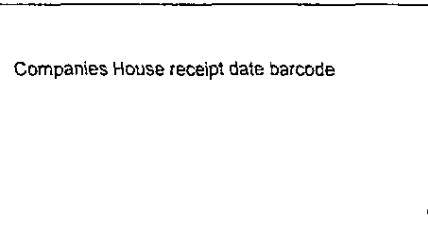

STATEMENT OF THE ADMINISTRATORS' PROPOSALS

Pursuant to Paragraph 49 of Schedule B1 to the Insolvency Act 1986; and
Rule 2.33 of the Insolvency Rules 1986

Please note that these Proposals are of a statutory nature and give enabling powers to the Administrators in order for them to continue to pursue the purposes of the Administration Order. Creditors should also note, for the avoidance of doubt, that these are NOT Voluntary Arrangement proposals.

1. Introduction

- 1.1 On 20 November 2009, pursuant to an application made by the Company, the company entered Administration in the High Court of Justice and we were appointed Joint Administrators. We were appointed to manage the affairs, business and property of the Company and will continue to act until our proposals for achieving the purpose of the Administration has been agreed by creditors and implemented. We are to act jointly and severally. The Company designed and installed office and commercial interiors.
- 1.2 Administration has the effect of freezing amounts owing to all creditors and, except with the leave of the Court or the consent of the Administrators, Administration stops legal proceedings against the Company. The intention of the legislation is to give the Company protection against claims, or attempts to wind the Company up, the enforcing of security, or the repossession of assets while efforts are made to achieve the purpose for which the Administration order was made.
- 1.3. The Administrators of a company must perform their functions with the objective of (in order of priority):
 - 1.3.1 rescuing the company as a going concern, or
 - 1.3.2 achieving a better result for the company's creditors as a whole than would be likely if the company were wound up (without first being in administration), or
 - 1.3.3 realising property in order to make a distribution to one or more secured or preferential creditors.

- 1.4 For the reasons set out in this report, in this case Administration was entered into for the purposes mentioned in paragraph 1.3.2 and 1.3.3. The Administrators have concluded that it was not reasonably practical to achieve a rescue of the Company as a going concern. The purpose of the Creditors' Meeting is to review the conduct of the Administration to date and to give appropriate powers and authority to the Administrators to achieve the purposes of the Administration as required by Paragraph 49 of Schedule B1 to the Insolvency Act 1986. These specific proposals do not exclude the exercise by the Administrators of their powers and duties under the Insolvency Act 1986 and the Insolvency Rules 1986 [as amended].

2. Statutory Information

- 2.1 Annexed to these Proposals are the following details:

- 2.1.1 An account of the circumstances giving rise to the application for Administration (Appendix A)
- 2.1.2 A summary of the company's statutory details at the date of Administration (Appendix B)
- 2.1.3 A Statement of Affairs as at the date of the Administration (Appendix C)
- 2.1.4 Rule 2.38 of The Insolvency Rules 1986, Entitlement to vote (Appendix D)

- 2.2 This Administration is considered to be main proceedings as defined in the EC Regulation No. 1346/2000.

3. Post-Administration Management

- 3.1 I attach as Appendix E, a summary of our receipts and payments account to date.

- 3.2 The sale of the business and assets was completed on 20 November 2009 immediately following our appointment and comprised the tangible office assets for an initial sum of £5,000 and debtors, retentions and net work-in-progress of £144,974. This figure is slightly lower than that shown in my initial letter to creditors included in my SIP 16 report as certain pre-Administration obligations were deducted from the funds transferred. The initial purchase consideration was received in full on 23

November. In addition, there is a deferred consideration for goodwill being 4% of the gross margin achieved on work done on existing customers over the next two years. The purchaser was Breathe London LLP, a newly-formed entity owned and controlled by Breathe Interiors Limited.

- 3.3 Certain assets not related to the current business were not included in the sale and principally comprise a profit rental of the Company's former Victoria offices which will be realised in the Administration.
- 3.4 It is believed that all employees of the Company were transferred under the sale agreement and that there will be no claims for arrears of wages, holiday pay and redundancy.
- 3.5 Following the completion of the sale, we have dealt with the inevitable day to day routine insolvency processes, including circulating an initial report to creditors and receiving and responding to claims made. This has included consideration of a number of claims under retention of title clauses. The secured creditor (NatWest Bank) has been repaid out of the sale proceeds and a Deed of Release of the charge issued.
- 3.6 A change in the name of the company is also being undertaken and this is in the process of being registered. The new name will be All Admin Limited.

4. The Exit Route from Administration

- 4.1 We anticipate that there will be funds available to pay a dividend available to unsecured creditors and in due course, we may seek to make an application to Court for power to distribute funds to creditors in the administration, to be followed by the Company's dissolution. In the alternative we will apply either to have the Company placed into Voluntary Liquidation or in the alternative propose a Company Voluntary Arrangement (CVA) for distribution purposes.

5. Other Matters

- 5.1 The Administrators have certain statutory responsibilities, including a review of the matters leading up to the financial problems and the directors' conduct. We are required by law under the Company Directors Disqualification Act 1986 to make a return or conduct report on every person who was on the date of our appointment or at any time in the three years immediately preceding that date a director or shadow director of the company. If you have any information which you consider may be relevant to our report please provide such information and any related evidence as soon as possible. Please note that this request forms part of my firm's usual investigation procedures and does not in any way imply that there may be any cause for concern regarding any person concerned with the company's affairs.

6. Forecast Outcomes

- 6.1 As mentioned earlier in this report, given the level of overall asset realisations and creditor claims, it is considered likely that there may be a return to creditors. At this stage, it is not possible to assess the likely level of deferred consideration which depends on the future performance of the business under its new ownership.

7. Administrators' Proposals

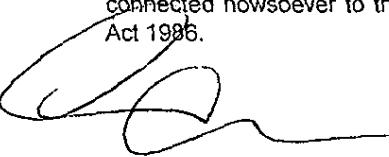
- 7.1 The following are our Statement of Proposals for achieving the purposes of the Administration Order made in respect of the Company and which we make to the creditors for their consideration and, if thought fit, approval at the Meeting of Creditors to be held on 8 January 2010.
- 7.2 That we be given authority to continue to manage the remaining affairs of the Company in such manner as we consider expedient with a view to achieving a better result for the Company's creditors as a whole than would be likely if the Company were wound up (without first being in Administration).
- 7.4 That we be empowered to review all existing contractual commitments and obligations of the Company and, where necessary, cause the Company to determine (if not already terminated) any such contractual commitments which, in our view, are not beneficial to the administration of the Company.
- 7.5 That we be empowered to enter into and conclude negotiations with creditors and/or others as we consider may assist in the administration.
- 7.6 That should the creditors so wish, a Committee of Creditors be elected in order to exercise the functions conferred on it by the Insolvency Act 1986.
- 7.7 That our remuneration for acting as Administrators be fixed by reference to the time properly given by us and our staff in attending to matters arising in the Administration and that the Administrators be at liberty to draw fees up to actual time costs incurred from time to time from funds held by us. That details of the remuneration drawn and time costs will be set out in the Administrators' progress reports as required by

the Association of Business Recovery Professionals. The present hourly charge out rates for principals and staff likely to be involved in this case are set out as follows together with details and charges for indirect disbursements:

- 7.7.1 Partners £270 - £290 Senior Professional Staff £110 - £220 and administrative and support staff £85 - £100.
- 7.7.2 Indirect disbursements to be charged at the rate of 25 pence per letter, 15 pence per photocopy and 40 pence per mile plus 5 pence for additional persons travelling in the same car.

Costs as at 5 December 2009 are £5,374 plus VAT and are summarised on the attached schedule in the format prescribed by the Association of Business Recovery Professionals.

- 7.8 That, if we so conclude is in the creditors interests, we convene further meetings of the creditors and members at such time as we may propose in order to put to them proposals for a CVA or to seek their approval to any other proposals.
- 7.9 That in the exercise of our powers and in doing anything where we believe it is appropriate or necessary to seek the consent or approval of creditors and, where the law so allows, any Committee of Creditors elected will have the authority to act on behalf of all creditors.
- 7.10 That we may do all such other things as we, in our discretion, consider will preserve protect or enhance the business and/or assets of the Company and/or are incidental to these proposals and their implementation.
- 7.11 That we take and implement such other consequential decisions as, in our judgement, will benefit the creditors of the Company.
- 7.12 Once the objective of the Administration has been achieved, it is proposed that we make an application to court for permission for the Administrators to distribute the funds held to non-preferential creditors. If permission is granted by the court, following the distribution to creditors, the Administrators propose to file notices pursuant to Paragraph 84(1) of Schedule B1 of the Insolvency Act 1986 with the Registrar of Companies, following registration of the notice the Company will be dissolved after a period of three months. If the court does not grant the necessary permission, the Administrators will place the Company into creditors' voluntary liquidation (CVL) or propose a CVA for the purposes of distributing the remaining funds.
- 7.13 If we determine that a CVL is the appropriate exit route, the proposed liquidators will be the current Administrators but in accordance with Paragraph 83(7) and Rule 2.117(3), creditors are advised that they may nominate a different person or persons, provided that the nomination is made after receipt of such proposals to put the Company into liquidation and before those proposals are approved.
- 7.14 That as soon as we deem it appropriate, we seek a discharge of the Administration and our release as Administrators. Following the filing of the Administrators' final progress report to the Registrar of Companies both Administrators will deemed to be released from any further liability arising from or connected howsoever to the Administration pursuant to Paragraph 98 of Schedule B1 of the Insolvency Act 1986.

ASSET INTERIORS LIMITED (In Administration) ("The Company")

An Account of the Circumstances giving rise to the Administration

- 1.1 Asset Interiors Limited ("the Company") was formed in February 2001 and traded as a Design and Build Commercial Interiors business. The Company is the wholly-owned subsidiary of Asset Interiors Holdings Limited, which was owned by six senior members of staff and a former owner of the business, Mr Alex Peers.
- 1.2 Atherton Bailey was first asked to advise in regard to the financial affairs of the Company in late July 2009 when Nigel Paul, a partner in Atherton Bailey was approached by the directors of the Company to give financial and business recovery advice to assist the Company in raising funds to support its trading. Prior to July 2009, neither Atherton Bailey nor any of its partners had any professional relationship with the Company. The assignment was initially to review the financial position of the Company and to support a proposed fund raising and/or a sale or merger. Detailed regard was given to the Company's precarious financial position and hence we advised on the setting up of a trust account arrangement for customer deposits etc and advised on issues relating to the directors' responsibilities.
- 1.3 Various negotiations were being entertained by the Company with a number of potential purchasers. These included several trade buyers, as well as potential investors introduced by Tenon Corporate Finance, Beer & Young (both of whom had been retained to find buyers or investors) and other parties known to individual directors. In September 2009, we assisted in detailed discussions with certain major supplier creditors regarding a debt/equity swap to restore the Company to solvency and this was agreed in principle and subsequently became an understanding whereby those creditors agreed to write-off their debts in full.
- 1.4 The Company's position then stabilised for a period in the light of further orders. However, most of the expressions of interest ultimately foundered for reasons connected with the Company's solvency, its reduced turnover and the general economic climate. In late October 2009, we were further instructed in regard to discussions which resulted in a draft proposal being received from Breathe Interiors Limited, a Cambridge-based company in a similar trade. We advised the Company at this stage that we considered such a sale of the Company's business and assets as a going concern was to the benefit of its creditors. The sale price negotiated was based on the book value of debtors, retentions and net work-in-progress plus a formula for goodwill.
- 1.5 By this stage, we had concluded that the Company was insolvent and would be unable to continue trading without formal insolvency protection. The detailed negotiations with Breathe led to a draft sale and purchase agreement being issued on 10 November 2009. We recommended that the Company be put into Administration in order to complete the transaction. Further details were included in the SIP 16 Report sent to creditors immediately following our appointment.
- 1.6 The decision to choose the Administration route rather than a creditors voluntary liquidation was principally that Administration gives greater protection to the assets of the Company and greater certainty during the realisation process. Certain assets, which may be claimed by third parties, may be capable of being realised in a more advantageous manner with the protection afforded to Administrators.

**Notes regarding Entitlement to Vote at the initial Creditors' Meeting
under paragraph 51 of Schedule B1 to the Insolvency Act 1986**

Rule 2.38 of The Insolvency Rules 1986 - Entitlement to Vote

2.38 (1) - Subject as follows, at a meeting of creditors in administration proceedings a person is entitled to vote only if:-

(a) he has given to the administrator, not later than 12.00 hours on the business day before the day fixed for the meeting, details in writing of the debt which

(i) he claims to be due to him from the company; or

(ii) in relation to a member State liquidator, is claimed to be due to creditors in proceedings in relation to which he holds office;

(b) the claim has been duly admitted under the following provisions of this Rule; and

(c) there has been lodged with the administrator any proxy which he intends to be used on his behalf,

and details of the debt must include any calculation for the purposes of Rules 2.40 to 2.42.

2.38 (2) - The chairman of the meeting may allow a creditor to vote, notwithstanding that he has failed to comply with paragraph (1)(a) if satisfied that the failure was due to circumstances beyond the creditor's control.

2.38 (3) - The chairman of the meeting may call for any document or other evidence to be produced to him, where he thinks it necessary for the purpose of substantiating the whole or any part of the claim.

2.38 (4) - Votes are calculated according to the amount of a creditor's claim as at the date on which the company entered administration, less any payments that have been made to him after that date in respect of his claim and any adjustment by way of set-off in accordance with Rule 2.85 as if that Rule were applied on the date that the votes are counted.

2.38 (5) - A creditor shall not vote in respect of a debt for an unliquidated amount, or any debt whose value is not ascertained, except where the chairman agrees to put upon the debt an estimated minimum value for the purpose of entitlement to vote and admits the claim for that purpose.

2.38 (6) - No vote shall be cast by virtue of a claim more than once on any resolution put to the meeting.

2.38 (7) Where

(a) a creditor is entitled to vote under this Rule;

(b) has lodged his claim in one or more sets of other proceedings; and

(c) votes (either in person or by proxy) on a resolution put to the meeting; and

(d) the member State liquidator casts a vote in respect of the same claim,

only the creditor's vote shall be counted.

2.38 (8) - Where

(a) a creditor has lodged his claim in more than one set of other proceedings; and

(b) more than one member State liquidator seeks to vote by virtue of that claim,

the entitlement to vote by virtue of that claim is exercisable by the member State liquidator in main proceedings, whether or not the creditor has lodged his claim in the main proceedings.

2.38 (9) - For the purposes of paragraph (6), the claim of a creditor and of any member State liquidator in relation to the same debt are a single claim.

2.38 (10) - For the purposes of paragraphs (7) and (8), "other proceedings" means main proceedings, secondary proceedings or territorial proceedings in another member State.
