Directors' report for the year ended 31st March 2011

The Directors of BE London East present their report and financial statements of the BE London East for the year ended 31st March 2011

Structure, Governance and Management

BE London East is the consortium organisation for the three Education Business Partnerships in Tower Hamlets, Hackney and Newham. These three EBPs are independent charities providing education/business link support in each of their respective boroughs.

BE London East is a company limited by guarantee.

Education Business Partnerships recruit local businesses and their staff to help young people in local Primary, Secondary and Special Needs Schools develop their work related skills

BE London East exists to share best practice amongst the three neighbouring East London boroughs and where appropriate to jointly bid for funds to deliver common programmes across the three boroughs

Each Director represents the interests of their local geographic area of East London

Objects and Activities

The three Education Business Partnership members of BE London East seek to encourage local businesses and their employees in their host borough to invest time and other resources in their local Primary, Secondary and Special Needs schools to help raise achievement and develop both basic, work related, enterprise and financial literacy skills amongst their students

Unemployment in London continues to be high, with youth unemployment a particular issue in the three Inner City boroughs of Hackney, Newham and Tower Hamlets – close to 25%

Worklessness and low skills are a challenge for London. Despite the recession, concern continues to be expressed about skills shortages, skills gaps and employability skills

Employers still report that recruits lack core employability skills such as communication and team working. Acquiring the skills, aptitudes and ability in order to apply learning in the workplace is as important as qualifications

Schools recognise that whilst they are equipped to focus on helping their students attain good levels of academic achievement, business has a key role in helping Schools develop amongst their students the essential work related skills demanded by employers

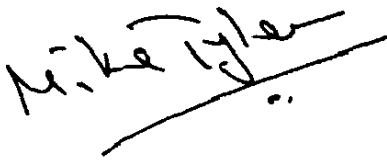
Business volunteers provide first hand experience of the world of work, helping young people in London better understand the career opportunities available to them and the skills and attitudes needed to successfully pursue their chosen careers

The three BE London East members deliver a range of structured activities into their local Schools, bringing business volunteers into contact with young people in the borough to help the young people develop their basic and work related skills, equipping young people with the life skills essential to helping them progress when they leave the education system

Financial Review

The unrestricted reserves of BE London East as at 1st April 2010 were £9,336. During the year £5,179 was distributed equally amongst five London boroughs who had been past members of BE London East. After payment of the Companies House filing fees of £30 BE London East has unrestricted reserves as at 31 March 2011 of £4,127.

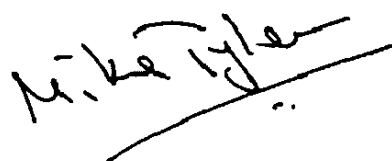
