GOVERNING BODY

The charity is an incorporated association governed by its memorandum and articles of association, together with its constitution.

OBJECT OF THE CHARITY/PRINCIPAL ACTIVITY

For the benefit of children in the care of foster families, particularly in the county of East Sussex, by provision of, or assistance in the provision of, facilities, advice, advocacy, training, and such other services as the trustees shall decide.

DECISION MAKING

The charity is managed by the Board of Directors which meet on a monthly basis.

REVIEW

The trustees submit their report together with the financial statements of the charity for the year ended 31 May 2005.

During the year arrangements were made for a third trip to the Isle of White which will take place in June 2005. Once again this has been made possible as a result of grants received during the year.

The charity also held several conferences in the period under review. These were also made possible because of grants received from various organisations during the period.

During the festive period a christmas party and a trip to the pantomime were organised.

FUTURE DEVELOPMENTS

The charity is committed to continuing to support foster carers in East Sussex and aims to take on a full time employee during the 2005/2006 period.

RESERVES POLICY

The Association is largely dependent on Project based funding for its operations. Since we are a non-profit making charity, in the directors opinion our reserves should represent a maximum of £10,000, plus the balance of any Project funding committed across the financial year.

REPORT OF THE DIRECTORS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 MAY 2005

RISK POLICY

The major risk faced by the charity is the lack of future funding to enable it to fulfil its activities and meet its underlying costs. The directors continue to seek new sources of funding to mitigate this risk.

STATEMENT OF DIRECTORS RESPONSIBILITIES

Company law requires the directors to prepare financial statements for each finacial year which give a true and fair view of the state of the affairs of the company and of the profit or loss of the company for that year. In preparing these the directors are required to:

NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS YEAR ENDED 31 MAY 2005

1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Basis of preparation of the accounts

The accounts are prepared under the historical cost convention and include the results of the charity's operations which are described in the Director's Report and all of which are continuing.

The accounts have been prepared in compliance with the Statement of Recommended Practice on Charity accounts.

The Charity has taken advantage of the exemption in Financial Reporting Standard 1 from the requirement to produce a cashflow statement.

Income

Voluntary income and donations are accounted for as received by the charity. Investment income is credited to income as received by the charity.

Management and administration costs

Administration costs include all expenditure not directly related to the charitable activity or fundraising ventures. This includes costs of running office premises, staff salaries for administration staff, and accountancy fees.

Taxation

The charity's activities are such that it should come within the scope of the exemption from taxation under S505 ICTA 1988, subject to the continuing requirement that income is applicable and applied for charitable purposes only.
