ORDER

UPON HEARING the Part 8 claim

AND UPON hearing Miss Minal Papat, Solicitor for the Claimant

AND UPON reading the Respondent's letter of no objection dated 16 June 2021

AND UPON the court being satisfied on the evidence that, pursuant to section 1096 (1) (a) of the Companies Act 2006, the accounts filed on 17 December 2020 for the Company were filed without the authority of the company as the full accounts were filed which included the profit and loss account.

AND the court being satisfied on the evidence that, pursuant to section 1096 (3) of the Companies Act 2006, that the accounts filed on 17 December 2020 for the Company have caused, or may cause, damage to the Company and that the Company's interest in removing the material outweighs any interest of other persons in the material continuing to appear on the register.

AND the court being satisfied that pursuant to section 1096(6)(b) and the courts powers pursuant to section 859M (2) (a) (i) of the Companies Act 2006, that there are grounds to rectify the register in that the omission or mis-statement was accidental or due to inadvertence or to some other sufficient cause.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Pursuant to section 1096 of the Companies Act 2006, the Registrar shall remove from the Public Register material comprising of the full accounts for the year ended 31 December 2019 for the Company filed at Companies House on 17 December 2020.
2. Pursuant to section 10 (1) of The Companies (Revision of Defective Accounts and Reports) Regulations 2008, the revised accounts having been approved by the directors under regulation 4, will have effect from the date of their approval and ought to be treated as placed on the Companies House register as at 17 December 2020, as the annual accounts of the company in place of the original accounts which were filed incorrectly on 17 December 2020.
3. No order as to costs.
